

ORDINANCE 4406

TO PROVIDE FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A FIRE LINE TAP FEE AND FOR THE AMENDMENT OF THE MASTER FEE SCHEDULE.

WHEREAS, the City of Hartsville approves certain fees and rates as part of its normal operations; and

WHEREAS, these fees and rates offset the costs of providing city services; and


WHEREAS, Section 2-107 (a)(1) of the Hartsville City Code states that "The council shall act by ordinance in all matters required by law to be done by ordinance, including to provide adjustment of service fees and service rates"; and

WHEREAS, the establishment and amendment of city fees and rates will be by reference and incorporated into the City's Master Fee Schedule, which is on file in the City Clerk's office.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the City of Hartsville that the establishment of a fire line tap fee in the amount of Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00) is hereby approved.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT FINALLY ORDAINED IN MEETING DULY ADVERTISED AND ASSEMBLED on the 8th day December 2020 and to become effective upon final reading.
