

ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 11, ARTICLE V, SECTION 11-138 THE GALLATIN  
MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO PEDDLERS, SOLICITORS, AND ITINERANT VENDORS  
BY ESTABLISHING A DO NOT SOLICIT LIST

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF GALLATIN, TENNESSEE, that Chapter 11, Article V, Sec.  
11-138 of the Gallatin Municipal Code, relative to restrictions on Peddlers, Solicitors, and Itinerant Vendors  
is hereby amended by adding a new subsection (9) which shall read as follows:

(9) The City Recorder shall maintain the do-not-solicit list.

Any property owner or tenant, if the property is leased, may elect to add or remove his or her  
residence to or from the list, at any time, by:

(i) Calling or visiting the City Recorder's offices;

(ii) Directing an email request to the City through a link to be maintained on the City's website for  
that purpose; or

(iii) Checking the appropriate box on the residence's Gallatin Public Utility bill when such option is  
provided annually;

(b) The do-not-solicit list shall be updated as follows:

(i) Every person who elects to add his or her residence to the do-not-solicit list shall be required to  
re-register such residence every five years. Any residence that is not re-registered in accordance with this  
section shall be removed from the do-not-solicit list; and

(ii) On a periodic basis, the City Recorder shall compare the do-not-solicit list to the utility database  
to identify which residences on the do-not-solicit list have been transferred or sold since being registered.  
The City Recorder shall remove any such residence;

(c) The City Recorder shall provide a copy of the do-not-solicit list to each person issued a license  
pursuant to this Article V. In addition, any person may obtain a copy of the do-not-solicit list by:

(i) Visiting the City Recorder's offices during normal business hours;

(ii) Visiting the City's Police Department any time twenty-four hours per day, seven days per week;

or

(iii) Accessing a copy from the City's website.

(d) No person shall enter onto the property of any residence listed on the do-not-solicit list maintained  
in accordance with subsection (a) hereof for the purpose of contact canvassing, peddling, vending, soliciting,  
or requesting contributions.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF GALLATIN, TENNESSEE, that this Ordinance shall take effect from and after its final passage, the public welfare requiring such.
