ORDINANCE NO. 2012-<u>12</u>

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 32, ARTICLE I, SECTION 32-1, OF THE TOWN OF MONCKS CORNER, SOUTH CAROLINA, CODE OF ORDINANCES RELATING TO OBSTRUCTION OF STREETS, SIDEWALKS AND FIRE HYDRANTS AND SAFE PASSAGE OF EMERGENCY VEHICLES.

Be it ordained by the Governing Body of the Town of Moncks Corner duly assembled that Chapter 32, Article I, Section 32-1 of the Town of Moncks Corner Code of Ordinance be amended to read as follows:

Sec. 32-1. Obstructing streets, sidewalks and fire hydrants. Safe passage of emergency vehicles.

It shall be unlawful to obstruct the streets, sidewalks or fire hydrants of the town with any vehicles, or to block any street, sidewalk or fire hydrant by persons congregating thereon or in immediate proximity thereof or to obstruct or hinder in any manner the safe and efficient passage of police, fire or emergency vehicles on the streets within the town.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED and ordered by the Mayor and Town Council of the Town of Moncks Corner, South Carolina, in Council duly assembled on July 17th, 2012, that Chapter 32, Article I, Section 32-1 of the Town of Moncks Corner Code of Ordinances is amended.
