**AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL AND RECREATE SECTION 42-40(f) OF THE CITY
CODE OF ORDINANCES CONCERNING HONORARY FIRE DEPARTMENT
MEMBERSHIP**


The Common Council of the City of Columbus, Columbia County, Wisconsin does hereby ordain as follows:

1. Section 42-40(f) Honorary Membership, is repealed in its entirety and recreated to now read as follows:
 - (f) *Honorary Membership.* Honorary membership shall be awarded to any member in good standing of the fire department that has provided fire service to Columbus or another department for a period of 15 or more years.
2. **Severability.** If any portion of this Ordinance or its application on any person or circumstances is held invalid, the validity of this Ordinance as a whole or any other provision herein or its application shall not be affected.
3. **Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and posting as required by law.
