ORDINANCE NO. 822AN ORDINANCE REPEALING AND RECREATING SEC. 18-1(a) AND CREATING SEC. 18-1(c) OF  
THE MUNICIPAL CODE

THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DELAFIELD, WAUKESHA COUNTY, WISCONSIN,  
DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION 1:** Sec. 18-1(a) of the City of Delafield Municipal Code is hereby repealed and recreated to read as follows:

- (a) Adoption of inter-municipal agreement. Pursuant to Article XIII of the inter-municipal agreement between the Villages of Nashotah, Chenequa, Oconomowoc Lake, and Wales, Towns of Delafield and Genesee, and the City of Delafield effective January 1, 2021, that created the current Lake Country Fire and Rescue, the terms of said inter-municipal agreement are incorporated herein and made part of this chapter along with any amendments duly made to such inter-municipal agreement adopted subsequent to its adoption, for purposes of creating the Lake Country Fire and Rescue, Lake Country Fire Board, and Lake Country Fire Commission referred to therein. A copy of the inter-municipal agreement as amended from time-to-time shall be attached hereto as an addendum.

**SECTION 2:** Sec. 18-1(c) of the City of Delafield Municipal Code is hereby created to read as follows:

- (c) Annual Fire Protection and Emergency Medical Service Fee. The Common Council may by resolution establish a fee for fire protection and emergency medical services payable annually by all property owners for the ongoing benefit of receiving and maintaining the current standard of such services. The fee shall be payable as a special charge placed on each property's tax bill and become delinquent if not paid within the time prescribed in Section 46-1 of the Code. The Common Council may by resolution adjust the amount of the fee or the calculation by which the fee is determined. The fee charged under this Section shall be in addition to the costs charged to a property owner for any fire or emergency medical service call pursuant to the inter-municipal agreement made part of Section 18-1(a) of the Code.

**SECTION 3:** This Ordinance is made pursuant to Wis. Stat. §§ 66.0627 and 66.0602(2m), and the Referendum approved by the electors on April 4, 2023.

**SECTION 4:** All Ordinances or parts of this Ordinance conflicting or contravening the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 5:** This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication or posting, as required by law.
