
ORDINANCE NO. 754

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ZONING CODE 17.39(7) THROUGH 17.39(15)
OF THE CITY OF DELAFIELD, WAUKESHA COUNTY, WISCONSIN**

The Common Council of the City of Delafield, Waukesha County, Wisconsin, does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1: Section 17.39(7)(m) of the Zoning Code is repealed and recreated to read as follows: Maximum floor area ratio. 0.25.

Section 17.39(8)(m) of the Zoning Code is repealed and recreated to read as follows: Maximum floor area ratio. 0.25.

Section 17.39(9)(n) of the Zoning Code is repealed and recreated to read as follows: Maximum floor area ratio. 0.40.

Section 17.39(10)(n) of the Zoning Code is repealed and recreated to read as follows: Maximum floor area ratio. 0.20.

Section 17.39(11)(n) of the Zoning Code is repealed and recreated to read as follows: Maximum floor area ratio. 0.50.

Section 17.39(12)(k) of the Zoning Code is repealed and recreated to read as follows: Maximum floor area ratio. 0.20.

Section 17.39(13)(l) of the Zoning Code is repealed and recreated to read as follows: Maximum floor area ratio. 0.25.

Section 17.39(14)(k) of the Zoning Code is repealed and recreated to read as follows: Maximum floor area ratio. 0.65.

Section 17.39(15)(a)(j) of the Zoning Code is repealed and recreated to read as follows: Maximum floor area ratio. 0.25.

SECTION 2: The terms and provisions of this ordinance are severable. Should any term or provision of this ordinance be found to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining terms and provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3: All ordinances and parts of ordinances in contravention to this ordinance are hereby repealed.


SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication or posting, as required by law.
