

ORDINANCE NO. 2019-195

ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF LAGUNA NIGUEL, CALIFORNIA,
AMENDING LAGUNA NIGUEL MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 7-4-603
TO IMPOSE TIME LIMIT PARKING RESTRICTIONS

The City Council of the City of Laguna Niguel does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Recitals.

1. The City Council of the City of Laguna Niguel has adopted parking prohibitions and restrictions in the Laguna Niguel Municipal Code; and
2. In response to increased demand for parking on Hidden Hills Road in front of Juaneño Park, City staff has proposed the adoption of time limited parking; and
3. The City staff presented a report entitled "Proposed Parking Restrictions on Hidden Hills for Juaneño Park" (the Report) to the Traffic and Transportation Commission detailing a proposed time limited parking restriction; and
4. The Report reviews the current parking and proposed time limited parking restrictions on Hidden Hills Road in front of Juaneño Park; and
5. The City Traffic & Transportation Commission considered the Report and made recommendations to the City Council; and
6. After considering the public testimony and documentation, the Report, and the recommendation of the Commission, the City Council desires to add time limited parking restrictions to the parking prohibitions in Section 7-4-603.

SECTION 2. Subsection (i) is added to Section 7-4-603 (Prohibited Parking) of Article 6 (Stopping, Standing and Parking of Vehicles) of Division (Traffic Ordinances) of Title 7 (Highways, Right-of-ways and Vehicles) to read as follows:

(i) Parking in a time limited parking zone.

- (1) No person shall park a motor vehicle at any place in the City in violation of the time limits approved by the City Council and for which a sign with the time limits is posted adjacent to the place.

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(2) The City Council approves a 2 hour time limit on the parking of motor vehicles on eastbound Hidden Hills Road in front of Juaneño Park between 7:00 am and 10:00 pm every day.

SECTION 3. Severability.

If any section, subsection, subdivision, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance is, for any reason, held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance. The City Council hereby declares that it would have adopted this Ordinance and each section, subsection, subdivision, sentence, clause, phrases, or portion thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions, sentences, clauses, phrases, or portions thereof be declared invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 4. Effective Date.


This Ordinance shall go into effect and be in full force and operation from and after thirty (30) days after its final passage and adoption.

SECTION 5. City Clerk's Certification.

The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this Ordinance and cause the same to be posted at the duly designated posting places within the City and published once within fifteen (15) days after passage and adoption as required by law; or, in the alternative, the City Clerk may cause to be published a summary of this Ordinance and post a certified copy of the text of this Ordinance in the Office of the City Clerk five (5) days prior to the date of adoption of this Ordinance, and, within fifteen (15) days after adoption, the City Clerk shall cause to be published the aforementioned summary and shall post a certified copy of this Ordinance, together with the vote for and against the same, in the Office of the City Clerk.
