ORDINANCE NO. 3702

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTIONS 1.89(2) and 1.89(7)(a) OF THE CODE OF GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF BELOIT PERTAINING TO THE TRAFFIC REVIEW COMMITTEE

The City Council of the City of Beloit, Rock County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. Section 1.89(2) of the Code of General Ordinances of the City of Beloit is hereby amended to read as follows:

- "(2) MEMBERSHIP. The Traffic Review Committee shall consist of 9 or 10 members as follows:
 - (a) Ex Officio Members.
 - 1. City Council President (optional).
 - 2. One City Council representative, who may also be the City Council President.
 - 3. Public Works Director
 - 4. City Engineer.
 - 5. Reserved
 - 6. Chief of Police or the Chief's designee.
 - 7. A representative of the Beloit School District.
 - (b) Citizen Members. Four citizen members.
 - (c) Rights and Privileges. All members of the Traffic Review Committee shall have the same rights and privileges, including the right to vote, except as follows:
 - 1. The City Council President and the City Council representative shall not have the right to vote unless a quorum would not otherwise be present, in which case the City Council President and the City Council representative shall be counted toward quorum and shall be deemed regular voting members.
 - 2. The Public Works Director shall not have the right to vote."

<u>Section 2</u>. Section 1.89(7)(a) of the Code of General Ordinances of the City of Beloit is hereby amended to read as follows:

"(a) Regular Meetings. Regular meetings of the committee shall be held at the location designated in the notice of the meeting on the fourth Monday of each even-numbered month."

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in force and take effect upon passage and publication.
