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Ordinance No. 4014

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 23.60 OF THE EDMOND MUNICIPAL CODE, STORMWATER QUALITY, BY ADDING NEW SECTION 23.60.045 REQUIRING COMPLIANCE WITH PERMIT CONDITIONS OF OPDES MULTI-SECTOR GENERAL PERMIT OKR05 FOR STORMWATER DISCHARGES FROM INDUSTRIAL ACTIVITY WITHIN THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA AS ISSUED BY THE OKLAHOMA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY; PROVIDING FOR REPEALER AND SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EDMOND, OKLAHOMA:

Section 1. Chapter 23.60 of the Edmond Municipal Code is hereby amending by adding new Section 23.60.045 – Industrial Stormwater Discharge to read as follows:

The industrial operator/owner shall remain responsible for the design, installation, inspection, and continual maintenance of all stormwater quality control Best Management Practices (BMPs). The Industrial Operator/Owner shall obtain the necessary permits from the Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) and the City of Edmond prior to any industrial activities. Installation of stormwater quality control BMPs is considered the number one priority before industrial activity takes place. DEQ's "OPDES Multi - Sector General Permit OKR05 For Storm Water Discharges from Industrial Activity Within The State Of Oklahoma" is hereby adopted by reference and its requirements shall apply to all sites covered by that permit. A copy is available for public inspection in the office of the Director of Engineering.

Section 2. REPEALER. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of any such conflict.

Section 3. SEVERABILITY. If any section, sub-section, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance is, for any reason, held invalid or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion of this Ordinance.

Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after passage.
