ORDINANCE NO. <u>2017-009</u>

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CASTROVILLE, TEXAS, ANNEXING CITY OWNED PROPERTY ACQUIRED IN 2016; PROVIDING DIRECTIVES TO CITY STAFF RELATED TO THE ANNEXATION; PROVIDING FOR A CUMULATIVE & CONFLICTS CLAUSE, PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, in 2016, the City of Castroville purchased a 23.60 acre tract and a 40.20 acre tract, both which are located within the City's extraterritorial jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, Texas Local Government Code Section 43.026 authorizes the City of Castroville to annex property it owns by Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF CASTROVILLE, TEXAS, THAT:

Section one. Findings. The City of Castroville City Council finds that title, rights and ownership of certain Real Property is vested in the City, as described below:

- A. Tract One 23.60 Acres of Land out of the International and Great Northern Railroad Company Survey 4/17, Abstract 1212, Medina County, Texas, being the south remnant of out of an 80 acre tract described in Volume 752 on page 1016 of the Official Public Records of Medina County, Texas, said 23.60 acres being more particularly described by metes and bounds on Exhibit "A" and the survey on Exhibit "B", both of which are attached hereto and made a part hereof for all purposes.
- B. Tract Two: 40.20 Acres of land out of the International and Great Northern Railroad Company Survey 4/17, Abstract 1212, Medina County, Texas, comprising a 20 acre tract out of 160 acres as described in Volume 212 on page 273 of the Deed Records and a 19.20 acre tract out of out of 80 acres as described in Volume 752 on page 1016 of the Official Public Records of Medina County, Texas, said 40.20 acres being more particularly described by metes and bounds on Exhibit "A" and the survey on Exhibit "B", both of which are attached hereto and made a part hereof for all purposes.

Section two. Annexation. City Council hereby annexes Tracts One and Two into the Corporate Limits of the City of Castroville.

Section three. Council directives. The City Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to take appropriate action to have the official map of the City revised to reflect the additions to the City's Corporate Limits and the City Secretary is hereby authorized and directed to provide appropriate notice to the State of Texas and the County of Medina of this annexation.

Section four. Cumulative and Conflicts. This Ordinance shall be cumulative of all provisions of ordinances of the City of Castroville, Texas, except where the provisions of the Ordinance are in direct conflict with the provisions of such ordinances, in which event the conflicting provisions of such ordinances are hereby repealed. Any and all previous versions of this Ordinance to the extent that they are in conflict herewith are repealed.

Section five. Severability. It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council that the phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, and sections of this Ordinance are severable, and if any phrase, clause sentence, paragraph or section of this Ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional by the valid judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs and sections of this Ordinance, since the same would have been enacted by the City Council without the incorporation in this Ordinance of any such unconstitutional phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section.

Section six. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
