

ORDINANCE NO. 4356

An Ordinance Amending City Code Section 6-4 as Last Amended by Ordinance No. 4270 Pertaining to Consumption of Alcoholic Beverages on Public Property

BE IT ORDAINED by the Governing Body of the City of Independence, Kansas:

Section 1. City Code Section 6-4 as last amended by Ordinance No. 4270 is amended as follows:

(a) Subsection (a) of City Code Section 6-4 is amended to delete the last sentence which states: “This prohibition shall not apply to City owned buildings managed or operated by the Independence Housing Authority for residential purposes.”

(b) A new subsection e. is added to City Code Section 6-4 as follows:

“e. The alcohol prohibition set forth in subsection (a) shall not apply to:

1. City owned buildings managed or operated by the Independence Housing Authority for residential purposes.

2. The holder of a special event permit issued by the city.

3. A city owned right of way or sidewalk which is the subject of an agreement between the city and the adjacent property owner which allows the property owner, or his lessee, to occupy and use the city right of way or sidewalk on a temporary basis.”

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its publication in the official City newspaper.
