

ORDINANCE NO. 4209

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING A SPECIAL TAX IN THE CITY OF INDEPENDENCE, KANSAS, ON THE PROPERTIES HEREINAFTER DESCRIBED FOR THE PURPOSE OF PAYING THE COST AND EXPENSE OF ABATING NUISANCES ON SAID PROPERTY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF INDEPENDENCE, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. There is hereby levied upon the properties hereinafter described in the City of Independence, Kansas, a special tax in nuisance on said property, all in the City of Independence, Kansas and described as follows:

LEGAL

Beginning 3 feet North of the SE Corner of Lot 6, Block 2, Shulthis Addition to the City of Independence, thence West 140 feet, North 45 feet, East 140 feet, South 5 feet to beginning, being a part of Lot 4, of Section 30, Township 32, Range 16, Montgomery County, Kansas.

COMMON: 515 N 8TH (GARAGE ONLY)

AMOUNT: \$ 290.39

LEGAL

Lots 5, Pavy's Second Addition to the City of Independence, Montgomery County, Kansas

COMMON: 1201 W MYRTLE

AMOUNT: \$285.18

LEGAL

Lot 3, County Clerk's Sub-division of Lots 8 to 19, inclusive, Westminster Sub-division of Out Lot 2, Montgomery County, Kansas

COMMON: 415 WESTMINSTER

AMOUNT: \$ 301.51

LEGAL

Lot 7, Block 3, Original City of Independence, Montgomery County, Kansas

COMMON: 404 N 4TH

AMOUNT: \$ 220.90

an expense incurred by said City for abating the nuisance from said properties, and after due and proper proceedings has been taken therefore, said Special Tax is hereby levied to pay the cost and expenses of abating nuisances as by law provided, in the amount set opposite each tract so described.


SECTION 2. It shall be the duty of the City clerk of Independence, Kansas, to certify to the County Clerk of Montgomery County, Kansas, the taxes levied against the property above described and provided for in

ORDINANCE NO. 4209

Section 1 of this Ordinance are to be placed upon the tax roles for collection subject to the same penalty and collected in the same manner as other taxes are by law collected.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force after its final passage and publication in the official paper of the City.
