AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 30  
OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES TO INCLUDE PROHIBITIONS  
PERTAINING TO THE IGNITION, DISCHARGE AND USE OF FIREWORKS  
WITHIN THE CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF MUSKEGON

**Ordinance No.12-12**

THE CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF MUSKEGON HEREBY ORDAINS:

- Section 1: Purpose. In order to protect the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Muskegon Charter Township, the Township desires to enforce certain regulations regarding the use, ignition and discharge of fireworks within the Township.
- Section 2: That Section 30-159 of Chapter 30 of the Code of Ordinances for the Charter Township of Muskegon be amended to read as follows:
- No person shall ignite, discharge, or use any consumer fireworks, pursuant to Public Act 256 of 2011, as amended, except on the day before, the day of and the day after a national holiday, unless prior approval was obtained from the Township Board.
- Section 3. Severability. Should any part of this ordinance be held invalid by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction, the remaining parts shall be severable and shall continue in full force and effect.
- Section 4. Ordinance Repeal. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.
- Section 5. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be effective upon adoption and publication.
