

ORDINANCE NO. 1802

**ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 70-169 PERTAINING
TO PARKING ON ROADWAYS**

**IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
NORTHPORT, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:**

1. That this Ordinance hereby amends Section 70-169 of the Municipal Code to include the following:

Section 70-169 – Parking on roadway for certain purposes prohibited.

- a. It shall be unlawful for any person to park an automobile, pickup truck or motorcycle upon any street, alley or public right of way of the City for a period of time in excess of seventy-two (72) consecutive hours.
- b. It shall be unlawful for any person to park a recreational vehicle upon any street, alley or public right of way of the City. However, a recreational vehicle may be temporarily parked upon a street, alley or public right of way in preparation for and returning from a trip using this recreational vehicle, provided that the time on any street, alley or public right does not exceed forty-eight (48) consecutive hours.
- c. It shall be unlawful for any person to park a commercial vehicle, equipment, boat, trailer, semi-trailer or any inoperable motor vehicle on any street, alley or public right of way of the City.
- d. It shall be unlawful for any person to place or store any type of dumpster upon any street, alley or public right of way without first obtaining a permit from the City for the temporary placement of the dumpster.
- e. It shall be unlawful for any person to place or store any portable storage unit upon any street, alley or public right of way of the City.

That all subsequent sections be re-lettered as appropriate.

3. The Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its adoption and publication as required by law.
