



## ORDINANCE NO. 3697

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, AMENDING THE FARMERS BRANCH CODE OF ORDINANCES, APPENDIX A "FEE SCHEDULE," RELATING TO VARIOUS FEES ESTABLISHED PURSUANT TO CHAPTERS 18, 22, 26, 34, 50, 56, AND 86 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Farmers Branch, Texas, finds it to be in the public interest to amend the City of Farmers Branch Code of Ordinances, Appendix A "Fee Schedule" and/or related sections of the Code of Ordinances in order to better reflect the cost of certain services provided by the City of Farmers Branch.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. The Code of Ordinances of the City of Farmers Branch, Appendix A "Fee Schedule" shall be amended as follows:


- (2) The "Fee for registration of certified backflow prevention assembly testers" authorized by Section 86-67(c) of the Code of Ordinances is repealed and deleted.


**SECTION 3.** This Ordinance shall be effective October 1, 2021, after final passage.


