



ORDINANCE NO. 3577

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, AMENDING THE FARMERS BRANCH CODE OF ORDINANCES, APPENDIX A “FEE SCHEDULE,” BY AMENDING THE FEES ESTABLISHED PURSUANT TO CODE OF ORDINANCES CHAPTER 22 “BUILDINGS AND BUILDING REGULATIONS,” ARTICLE II “ADMINISTRATION,” SECTIONS 22-51, 22-52, AND 22-58; PROVIDING A REPEALING CLAUSE; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Farmers Branch, Texas, finds it to be in the public interest to amend the City of Farmers Branch Code of Ordinances, Appendix A “Fee Schedule” with respect to permit fees relating to the construction of residential dwellings to conform to the provisions of Texas Local Government Code §214.907 which became effective on May 21, 2019.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. The Code of Ordinances of the City of Farmers Branch, Appendix A “Fee Schedule” relating to the fees established pursuant to Section 22-51, 22-52, and 22-58 of the Code of Ordinances shall be amended to read as set forth in Exhibit “A”, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION 2. All provisions of the Ordinances of the City of Farmers Branch, Texas, in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance be, and the same are hereby, repealed, and all other provisions of the Ordinances of the City not in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. Should any sentence, paragraph, subdivision, clause, phrase or section of this Ordinance be adjudged or held to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole, or any part or provision thereof other than the part so decided to be invalid, illegal or unconstitutional, and shall not affect the validity of the Code of Ordinances as a whole.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect immediately following its passage in accordance with the provisions of the charter and state law; provided, however, the calculation of permit fees and charges with respect to residential dwellings as amended pursuant to Section 1 of this Ordinance shall be effective retroactively with respect to building permit and inspection fees assessed with respect to a residential dwelling on or after May 21, 2019, it being the intent that the fees and the manner of calculation thereof in effect prior to the effective date of Texas Local Government Code §214.907 shall remain in effect and be assessed for permits and inspections prior to May 21, 2019.




