

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND
THE CITY OF MONROE, GEORGIA MUNICIPAL CHARTER**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MONROE, GEORGIA, TO AMEND THE MUNICIPAL CHARTER APPROVED BY LOCAL ACT OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA INCORPORATING THE CITY OF MONROE APPROVED APRIL 8, 1971 (GA. LAWS 1971 p. 3221), AS AMENDED, SO AS TO CHANGE ARTICLE VI, MUNICIPAL UTILITIES, SECTION 6.04 EXPANSION FUND AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Pursuant to the authority granted to municipalities in O.C.G.A. §36-35-3, be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Monroe, Georgia that the Charter of Monroe, Georgia Law 1971 p. 3221, as amended, shall be amended as follows:

ARTICLE I

Amend Article VI, Municipal Utilities, by deleting Section 6.04 in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof a new Section 6.04 to read as follows:

Sec. 6.04. Expansion fund.

Five percent of the gross revenue received per month from the operation of any utility systems shall be placed in a reserve fund separate from all other funds. The money in this fund shall be used for expansion or major maintenance and repair expense of any of the city's utility systems. When the aggregate amount in this fund exceeds 20 percent of the gross receipts for the previous year, excess monies shall be appropriated at the discretion of the Mayor and Council.

ARTICLE II

All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

ARTICLE III
