

ORDINANCE NO. 620 2ND SERIES

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF EAGAN, MINNESOTA AMENDING EAGAN CITY CODE CHAPTER TWELVE ENTITLED “COMPREHENSIVE GUIDE PLAN AND LAND USE REGULATIONS – INTERIM USE STUDY” BY ADDING SECTION 12.08 ENTITLED “INTERIM USE: CANNABIS RESTRICTIONS STUDY”; AND BY ADOPTING BY REFERENCE EAGAN CITY CODE CHAPTER 1 AND SECTION 11.99.

The City Council of the City of Eagan does ordain:

Section 1. Eagan City Code, Chapter 12, is hereby amended by adding Section 12.08 to read as follows:

Section 12.08. Interim Use: Cannabis Restrictions Study

- A. On June 20, 2023, the Eagan City Council directed a study to be conducted for the purpose of evaluating whether to place restrictions on the establishment or operations of cannabis businesses.
- B. It is in the City’s best interest to restrict the sale of cannabis products while the study is on-going.
- C. All property located within the City of Eagan (the “Property”) is affected by this interim use ordinance.
- D. This interim use ordinance is adopted and is applicable to the Property for the purpose of protecting the planning process and the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Eagan.
- E. Commencing on the effective date of this interim use ordinance and ending on January 1, 2025, or such sooner time as the City Council may determine, the Property shall be subject to the following:

No Property may be used for the operation of a cannabis business.

Section 2. Eagan City Code Chapter 1 entitled “General Provisions and Definitions Applicable to the Entire City Code Including ‘Penalty for Violation’” and Section 12.99 entitled “Violation of a Misdemeanor” are hereby adopted in their entirety by reference as though repeated verbatim.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect upon its adoption and publication according to law.
