ACCOMACK COUNTY, VIRGINIA, AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 30 OF THE ACCOMACK COUNTY CODE, ENTITLED "COURTS," SECTION 30-3 THEREOF, TO CHANGE THE COURTHOUSE SECURITY FEE FROM \$10.00 TO \$20.00 PER CRIMINAL CONVICTION OR TRAFFIC INFRACTION AS PERMITTED BY SECTION 53.1-120 OF THE CODE OF VIRGINIA.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Virginia Code, 1950, as amended, §53.1-120, there is imposed a \$10 fee, levied as part of the costs in each criminal or traffic case in its district or circuit court in which the defendant is convicted of a violation of any statute or ordinance, to cover the cost of courthouse security personnel; and

WHEREAS, said Code allows a sum not in excess of \$20 for costs as part of the costs in each criminal or traffic case in its district or circuit court in which the defendant is convicted of a violation of any statute or ordinance; and

WHEREAS, The Accomack County Board of Supervisors wishes to update the Accomack County Code to reflect an increase in the fee from \$10.00 to \$20.00 as permitted by said Code of Virginia.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Accomack County Board of Supervisors at a meeting in regular session this 18th day of November, 2020, that Chapter 30, Sec. 30-3, Assessment for courthouse security personnel, of the Code of Ordinances, Accomack County, Virginia, be amended, as follows:

Sec. 30-3. - Assessment for courthouse security personnel.

An assessment of a sum of ~~\$10.00~~ \$20.00 is levied as part of the costs in each criminal or traffic case in its district or circuit court in which the defendant is convicted of a violation of any statute or ordinance. This assessment shall be collected by the clerk of the court in which the case is heard, remitted to the treasurer of Accomack County and held by the treasurer subject to the appropriation by the board of supervisors of the County of Accomack to the sheriff of the County of Accomack for the funding of courthouse security personnel.

This Ordinance amendment is effective upon adoption.
