

**Village of Menomonee Falls Ordinance No. 861-O-22**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 42-18  
OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF MENOMONEE FALLS  
RELATING TO IMPACT FEES**

**WHEREAS**, it is deemed to be in the best interest of the Village of Menomonee Falls that the Municipal Code of the Village of Menomonee Falls be further modified and amended in a manner hereinafter more particularly set forth;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Village Board of the Village of Menomonee Falls do ordain as follows:

**Section 1.** Section 42-18 [*Buildings and Building Regulations*] of Article I [*In General*] of Chapter 42 [*Fees*] of the Menomonee Falls Municipal Code is hereby repealed and recreated to read as follows:

**Sec. 42-18. Buildings and building regulations.**

(a) *Building permit.*

- (1) Fees. Before receiving a building permit, the owner or the owner's agent shall pay the fee specified in Table 1 of this section. In applying the provisions of this Code in respect to new work, existing buildings, alterations or repairs, the physical value of the work shall be determined by the village manager or designee on the basis of current costs, or as otherwise provided by ordinances.

(2) *Cash deposit.* The cash deposit for damage to public health facilities during construction of new residential uses shall be \$1,000.00.

(b) *Electrical permit fees.*

(1) The following fees and inspection charges shall be made for all permit fees issued under chapter 3 of the electrical code:

(c) *Plumbing.*

(1) Permit fees. The schedule of permit fees issued under the plumbing code shall be as follows:

(a)	Fixtures, as follows: sinks, water closets, baths (any description), washbasins, laundry trays, wash machine connection, urinals, floor drains, bar and soda fountains, ice makers, drinking fountains, in-line coffee machine, water treatment devices, catch basins, sump pits and ejectors, water heaters, food waste disposals, dishwashers, shower stalls, hose bibbs, sprinkling meters, water softeners or filters, receptors (all types), pressure reducing valves, backflow preventers,	\$12.00 each
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	air admittance valves, grease interceptors, conductors, manholes, sprinkling/deduct meter, equipment connections, etc.,	
(b)	Building sanitary or storm sewers from main or lateral to building	\$55.00 first 100 feet or part thereof. \$0.35 each foot over 100 feet
(c)	Water service (a water meter pit is required for all laterals longer than 300 feet)	\$55.00 first 100 feet or part thereof. \$0.35 each foot over 100 feet
(d)	Private well or well pump	\$50.00 each
(e)	Well abandonment	\$100.00 each
(f)	Special inspection request	\$150.00 per hour
(g)	Reinspection fee or code violations	\$75.00 per inspection
(h)	Minimum plumbing permit fee(non-refundable): plumbing	\$60.00
(i)	Failure to take out permit before commencing work	Double fee
(j)	Failure to call for required inspections	\$70.00
(k)	Gas piping per fixture	\$12.00
(l)	Miscellaneous repair or replacement of interior piping	\$50.00
(m)	Water heater or softener	\$12.00 each

(2) *Holding tank.* The cash bond referenced in subsection 18-331(b) is \$0.02 per gallon of the holding tank capacity.

**Section 2.** Except as specifically modified and amended by this ordinance, the Municipal Code of the Village of Menomonee Falls shall remain in force and effect exactly as originally adopted and previously amended. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with or in contravention of the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

**Section 3.** This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and publication.

**Section 4. SEVERABILITY.** If a court of competent jurisdiction adjudges any section, clause, provision or portion of this ordinance unconstitutional or invalid, the remainder of this ordinance shall not be affected thereby.
