

Village of Menomonee Falls Ordinance No. 908-O-24

**AN ORDINANCE ADJUSTING THE
COMPENSATION RECEIVED BY THE VILLAGE BOARD**

WHEREAS, Wisconsin Statute § 61.32, § 66.0505 and § 61.193 authorize the Board of Trustees to set the salary for trustees and the village president; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 2-2 of the Municipal Code, the village president and trustees shall receive such compensation as may be established by the village board by ordinance from time to time; and

WHEREAS, the current annual salaries for the Village Board members are \$5,500.00 for each trustee seat and \$7,500.00 for the village president; and

WHEREAS, the annual salary for Village trustees and the village president has not been increased in more than twenty (20) years; and

WHEREAS, the accumulative rate of inflation in the United States of America from 2000 to 2024 is roughly 72%, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees deems it to be in the best interest of the Village of Menomonee Falls to increase the compensation of the Village's elected officials in accordance with the annual inflation rate; and

NOW, THEREFORE, the Village Board of the Village of Menomonee Falls do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Beginning on January 1, 2027, the village president shall receive an annual compensation of \$13,795.00 and each trustee shall receive an annual compensation of \$10,800.00.

Section 2. The annual compensation for the village president and each trustee shall increase by two percent (2%) annually on January 1 of each year beginning in 2028.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage.

Section 4. SEVERABILITY. If a court of competent jurisdiction adjudges any section, clause, provision or portion of this resolution unconstitutional or invalid, the remainder of this resolution shall not be affected thereby.
