ORDINANCE OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

Serial No. 2012-42

An Ordinance Relating to Shooting Ranges.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature and shall become a part of the City and Borough Code.

Section 2. Amendment of Section. CBJ 42.20.050 - Discharging firearms, is amended at 42.20.050(a) to read:

42.20.050 - Discharging firearms.


(a) It is unlawful for any person except a peace officer in the line of duty, to fire or discharge any firearm within one-quarter mile of any public street, road or highway within the City and Borough of Juneau, except that it is not unlawful to discharge:

- (1) a shotgun within the Mendenhall Wetlands State Game Refuge;
- (2) a firearm at a shooting range operated by the Hank Harmon Memorial Rifle Range, the Juneau Gun Club, or the federal or state government; or
- (3) a firearm at a shooting range approved as required under CBJ 49.25.300, Table of Permissible Uses.



Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be effective 30 days after its adoption.
