

**GILCHRIST COUNTY, FLORIDA**

**ORDINANCE NO. 2013-04**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF GILCHRIST COUNTY, FLORIDA ESTABLISHING A 30-MILE-PER-HOUR SPEED LIMIT ON SOUTHWEST 80<sup>TH</sup> STREET WEST FROM COUNTY ROAD NUMBER 307 TO SOUTHWEST 83<sup>RD</sup> TERRACE; CORRECTING A SCRIVENOR'S ERROR FOUND IN THE CODE OF ORDINANCES AT SECTION 82-2 (c)(14); AND DELETING DUPLICATIONS AND ERRONEOUS REFERENCE FOUND IN SECTION 82-2 (e)(2) and (f)(7) THEREOF AND AUTHORIZING THE CODIFIER TO RE-NUMBER THE SAME; MAKING FINDINGS; PROVIDING PENALTY FOR VIOLATION; PROVIDING INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CODIFIER; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners of Gilchrist County, Florida is responsible for the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Gilchrist County; and

**WHEREAS**, it is determined that establishing a low speed limit on Southwest 80<sup>th</sup> Street West from County Road Number 307 to Southwest 83<sup>rd</sup> Terrace is necessary to protect the safety of the public; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 316.189, Florida Statutes authorizes counties to establish and set speed zones.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF GILCHRIST COUNTY, FLORIDA:**

**Section 1.** The Code of Ordinances of Gilchrist County, Florida, Section 82-2 is amended as follows:

**Sec. 82-2. Speed Limits**

(a) The following schools zones are hereby created:

- (1) Immediately adjacent to the Bell High School and the Bell Elementary School, outside the Bell Town limits from 30 minutes prior to the beginning of any school activity, including any breakfast program prior to the beginning of school, each school day until 10 minutes after the beginning of school; and from the end of the

school day until 30 minutes after the end of the school day. The speed limit within the school zone shall be 15 miles per hour.

- (2) Immediately adjacent to the Riverside Christian School on County Road SW 341 from 30 minutes prior to the beginning of any school activity, including any breakfast program prior to the beginning of school, each school day until 10 minutes after the beginning of school; and from the end of the school day until 30 minutes after the end of the school day. The speed limit within this school zone shall be 30 miles per hour.

(b) There shall be a 25-mile-per-hour speed limit on the following county roads and the posting of the 25-mile-per hour speed:

- (1) The speed limit immediately adjacent to the Bell High School and the Bell Elementary School, outside the Bell Town limits, at times other than specified in subsection (a)(1).

(c) There shall be a 30-mile-per-hour speed limit on the following county roads and the posting of the 30-mile-per-hour speed:

- (1) Waccassa Road, from one-fourth mile north of SE 78<sup>th</sup> Street to one-fourth mile south of SE 88<sup>th</sup> Lane.
- (2) Gay Road, NW 30<sup>th</sup> Street from SR 49 (U.S. 129) to NW 20<sup>th</sup> Avenue to CR 340.
- (3) CR 232, from SR 26 north to Nature Coast Trail.
- (4) SE 64<sup>th</sup> Street from CR 337 east to SR 26.
- (5) NW 67<sup>th</sup> Terrace from CR 340 south to NW 35<sup>th</sup> Street.
- (6) SE 40<sup>th</sup> Street from CR 337 to SE 57<sup>th</sup> Court.
- (7) Northwest 60<sup>th</sup> Street between U.S. Highway 129 and Northwest 50<sup>th</sup> Avenue.
- (8) SW 32<sup>nd</sup> Place from U.S. Highway 129 east to SW 37<sup>th</sup> Trail.
- (9) SW 37<sup>th</sup> Trail from SW 32<sup>nd</sup> Place to SW 17<sup>th</sup> Court.
- (10) SW 17<sup>th</sup> Court from SW 50<sup>th</sup> Street to SW 32<sup>nd</sup> Place.
- (11) SW 50<sup>th</sup> Street from U.S. Highway 129 to the end of said SW 50<sup>th</sup> Street.
- (12) SE 50<sup>th</sup> Street from CR 337 to the end of said SE 50<sup>th</sup> Street.



- (13) SW 10<sup>th</sup> Street from CR 341 to U.S. Highway 129.
  - (14) NW 5<sup>th</sup> Street from U.S. Highway 129 to Southwest 22<sup>nd</sup> Court.
  - (15) SW 22<sup>nd</sup> Court from NW 5<sup>th</sup> Street to SW 17<sup>th</sup> Place.
  - (16) SW 47<sup>th</sup> Court between CR 232 and CR 344.
  - (17) Southeast 97<sup>th</sup> Trail between CR 319 and SE 25<sup>th</sup> Avenue.
  - (18) Northwest 47<sup>th</sup> Place between NW 45<sup>th</sup> Avenue and U.S. Highway 129.
  - (19) Northeast 2<sup>nd</sup> Court in its entirety.
  - (20) Northwest 72<sup>nd</sup> Place, between U.S. Highway 129 and N.W. 22<sup>nd</sup> Court.
  - (21) Southwest 70<sup>th</sup> Street between Southwest 80<sup>th</sup> Avenue and County Road 232.
  - (22) Northwest 52<sup>nd</sup> Place, between U.S. Highway 129 and NW 22<sup>nd</sup> Court.
  - (23) Southwest 40<sup>th</sup> Street, between U.S. Highway 129 and County Road 341.
  - (24) Southwest 15<sup>th</sup> Court, between Southwest 100<sup>th</sup> Street and the City Limits of the City of Trenton.
  - (25) Southwest 25<sup>th</sup> Place from Southwest 25<sup>th</sup> Street to the terminus of Southwest 25<sup>th</sup> Place.
  - (26) Southeast 60<sup>th</sup> Street between County Road 337 and Southeast 60<sup>th</sup> Avenue.
  - (27) Southwest 80<sup>th</sup> Street between County Road 341 and County Road 232.
  - (28) Southwest 42<sup>nd</sup> Court from County Road 232 south to the end of Southwest 42<sup>nd</sup> Court.
  - (29) Southwest 70<sup>th</sup> Street from County Road 341 west to the Suwannee River.
  - (30) Northwest and Northeast 112 Place from NW 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue to Northeast 2<sup>nd</sup> Way.
  - (31) Southwest 80<sup>th</sup> Street West from County Road Number 307 to Southwest 83<sup>rd</sup> Terrace.
- (d) There shall be a 35 mile-per-hour speed limit on the following county roads and the posting of the 35-mile-per-hour speed:

(1) NW 55<sup>th</sup> Street, from the intersection with NW 55<sup>th</sup> Avenue west to the end of NW 55<sup>th</sup> Street.

(e) There shall be a 40-mile-per-hour speed limit on the following county roads and the posting of the 40-mile-per-hour speed:

(1) Northwest 10<sup>th</sup> Street from the Bell town limits west to the terminus of Northwest 10<sup>th</sup> Street in Section 29, Township 8 South, Range 15 East, except within school zones during posted hours.

~~(2) Northwest 60<sup>th</sup> Street between U.S. Highway 129 and Northeast 50<sup>th</sup> Avenue. [Deleted].~~

(3) SE 25<sup>th</sup> Avenue south of State Road 26 to the Gilchrist County Line.

(f) There shall be a 45-mile-per-hour speed limit on the following county roads and the posting of the 45-mile-per-hour speed:

(1) CR 232, north of Nature Coast Trail for 1 mile.

(2) CR 340 from the Dixie County Line east for one half mile.

(3) CR 232 between the intersection of CR 232 with U.S. Highway 129 and a point one mile east of the intersection of CR 132 and U.S. Highway 129.

(4) CR 340 for a distance of one half mile east and a distance of one mile west of the intersection of said CR 340 with U.S. Highway 129.

(5) CR 307 between CR 344 and State Road 129.

(6) Southwest 20<sup>th</sup> Street between County Road 341 and Southwest 75<sup>th</sup> Avenue.

~~(7) Southwest 70<sup>th</sup> Street between County Road 232 and Southwest 80<sup>th</sup> Avenue. [Deleted].~~

(8) County Road 307A between U.S. Highway 129 and a point 640 feet west of the west driveway entrance to the Gilchrist County Senior Center.

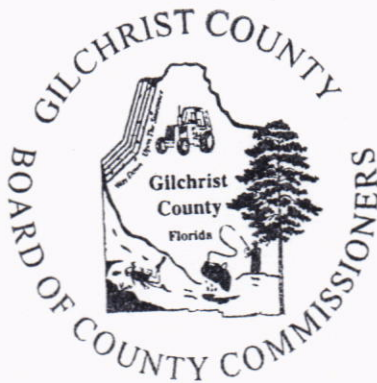
(g) The Board of County Commissioners authorizes the expenditure of county funds for the erection of speed limit signs in the affected areas listed in subsections (a)-(f) of this section. Signs shall be erected in accordance with the standards for speed limit signs as contained in the Florida Administrative Code.

(h) Violation of the speed limits established under this section shall be cited as a moving violation, punishable as provided in Chapter 318, Florida Statutes.


**Section 2.** The Codifier shall include Section 1 of this ordinance in the code of Ordinances of Gilchrist County. Language underlined is added. Language with a line through the same shall be deleted, and these sub-sections re-numbered.

**Section 3.** A certified copy of this ordinance shall be filed with the Department of State by the clerk of the Board of County Commissioners and shall take effect upon receipt of official acknowledgement from the Department of State that this ordinance has been filed.
