

(c) As referenced in this ordinance, the term “other misbehavior” shall be limited to: (1) the unlawful sale or unlawful use of illegal drugs, controlled substances, or marijuana; (2) prostitution; (3) disorderly conduct; (4) breaches of the peace; (5) affray; (6) loitering or prowling; and (7) public drunkenness.

(d) Penalty: Any person who violates this ordinance shall, upon conviction in the Oglethorpe County Magistrate Court, be fined in an amount not to exceed one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) or imprisoned for a period not to exceed sixty (60) days, or both, at the discretion of the Oglethorpe County Magistrate Court.”

2.

All ordinances and provisions thereof in conflict with the terms of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

3.

The general requirement set forth in Section 2-22(b)(8)(c)(4) of The Code of Oglethorpe County that a proposed ordinance be read at two consecutive meetings of the Board of Commissioners is hereby waived and, accordingly, the general requirement set forth in Section 2-22(b)(8)(c)(3) of The Code of Oglethorpe County that a proposed ordinance not be put on its final passage on the same day it is introduced is hereby waived.

4.

This ordinance shall take effect ten (10) days after its adoption.
