cohesion and goodwill. Or for a charitable purpose such as to raise money to donate to community family or community organizations in need. Community bingo games are limited to awarding prizes that have a minimal value. In this context, "minimal value" means an individual prize has a value no greater than two-hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00), and no community bingo game may offer a cash prize; provided, however, that gift cards for goods or services may be offered as prizes so long as such gift cards do not exceed a value of two-hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00) per gift card.

10 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that all ordinances that are inconsistent with this ordinance are 11 rescinded, and that this ordinance shall become effective when ratified by the 12 Principal Chief.
