

**ORDINANCE NO. 2023-002**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE  
CODE OF ORDINANCES OF  
THE CITY OF VALLEY, ALABAMA**

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Council of the City of Valley, Alabama (the "**City**") did, on the 12th day of January 2009, adopt Ordinance Number 2009-001 "WRECKER/TOWING SERVICE ORDINANCE" (hereinafter the "**Ordinance**"); and

**WHEREAS**, Section VIII of the Ordinance sets forth a fee schedule for the calculation and establishment of towing/wrecker/storage fees; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Council of the City deem it to be in the best interests of the City and of its citizens to amend said Article VIII of the Ordinance in order to amend the fee schedule for fees charged by towing companies for services rendered to the City; and

**WHEREAS**, in order to effect the desired change regarding the towing/wrecker/storage fees for vendors/companies providing such services it is necessary to amend the Ordinance.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VALLEY, ALABAMA AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. Ordinance No. 2009-001 ("**Wrecker/Towing Service Ordinance**") of the City of Valley, Alabama is hereby amended by deleting present Section C of Article VIII in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof a new Section C of Article VIII which shall read in words as follows:

**"C. Price Requirements for Valley Police Department Rotation**

<b>Passenger Vehicle</b>	<b>\$200 Impound/\$225 Wreck</b>
<b>Night/Weekend/Holiday</b>	<b>\$225 Impound/\$300 Wreck</b>
<b>Rate Per Mile</b>	<b>\$4 One Way</b>
<b>Rate Per Man Hour</b>	<b>\$75 (only if tow takes more than 1 hour)</b>
<b>Storage</b>	<b>\$35 per day/ \$75 covered or inside</b>

**Additional Fees**

<b>Roll Over</b>	<b>\$200</b>
<b>Winch</b> <i>cable)</i>	<b>\$75 (only if requires more than vendor's</b>
<b>No Key</b>	<b>\$50</b>
<b>Oil Dry</b>	<b>\$25 per bag</b>
<b>Window Wrap</b>	<b>\$25 per window/\$150 entire vehicle</b>
<b>Additional Truck</b>	<b>\$175 per hour</b>
<b>Abandoned Vehicle Fee</b>	<b>\$100</b>

***Any violation of the above pricing requirements will cause the violating company to be suspended from the towing rotation for one month for the first violation. Any subsequent violation may result in the permanent suspension and removal of the violating company from the City rotation schedule."***

Section 2. Ordinance Number 2009-001 is hereby deemed amended in its entirety in order to effect the above changes.

Section 3. This ordinance shall become effective \_\_\_\_\_, 2023.
