ORDINANCE NO. O-146-22

AN ORDINANCE relating to Chapter 16, FOOD SERVICE AND FOOD SERVICE ESTABLISHMENTS, amending Section 16-31, 16-32 & 16-34 of the Unified Government Code.

WHEREAS, retail food establishments measuring greater than 200 cubic feet and selling only prepackaged foods are required to be inspected and licensed by the Kansas Department of Agriculture annually; and

WHEREAS, there are 205 licensed retail food establishments in Wyandotte County; and

WHEREAS, the Kansas Department of Agriculture adopted the current Food Code in 2012; and

WHEREAS, the Kansas Department of Agriculture inspects and licenses all food establishments annually under the 2012 Food Code; and

WHEREAS, the Kansas Department of Health and Environment revoked their food regulations in 2010.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE UNIFIED GOVERNMENT OF WYANDOTTE COUNTY/KANSAS CITY, KANSAS:

Section 1. That Chapter 16, Article II, of the Code of Ordinances of the Unified Government of Wyandotte County/Kansas City, Kansas, be and is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 16-31. - 2012 Food Code adopted.

The Kansas Food Code, adopted in 2012, prepared, compiled and promulgated by the state department of agriculture, is adopted by reference.

Sec. 16-32. - State administrative regulations adopted.

The provisions of K.A.R.4-28-1 through 4-28-34, as they exist on the effective date of this Code, are adopted by reference as if set out in full in this article.


Sec. 16-34. - Permit Required.

All food establishments, as defined by the 2012 Food Code, located within Wyandotte County must obtain and maintain all Kansas Department of Agriculture required permits and licenses.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force upon its passage, approval, and publication in the official Unified Government newspaper.


