Trustee R. Glenn supported by Trustee T. Chastain, moved the adoption of the following Ordinance:

**ORDINANCE NO. 172**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTIONS 19.053 THROUGH 19.055 OF THE  
COMPILED CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF MACKINAW CITY RELATING TO  
PARKING VIOLATION BUREAU**

The Village of Mackinaw City ordains:

Sec. 1. Amendment of Compiled Code. Sections 19.053 through 19.055 of the Compiled Code of the Village of Mackinaw City (Ord. No. 70, Adopted August 5, 1971, amended November 19, 2009) is amended to read as follows:

19.053 - Settling of violations at bureau, court.

Sec. 3. The Parking Violations Bureau shall settle only those parking violations requested by the alleged violator. No penalty for any violation shall be accepted from any person who denies having committed the offense, and in no case shall the person who is in charge of the bureau determine or attempt to determine the falsity or any fact relating to such alleged violations. Any alleged violator contesting the violation has a right to do so before the District Court. If desired to contest the violation, the alleged violator will be issued a court traffic ticket by an on-duty Mackinaw City Police Department police officer for the violation which will allow the case to be heard in District Court.

19.054 – Court Traffic ticket or notice of violation.

Sec. 4. The issuance of a court traffic ticket or a notice of violation by a police officer of the Mackinaw City Police Department shall be considered an allegation of a parking violation. Such court traffic ticket or notice of violation shall indicate the length of time in which the person to whom issued must respond before the court of jurisdiction or the Parking Violations Bureau. A notice of violation shall also indicate the address of the Parking Violations Bureau, the hours during which the bureau is open, and the amount of the fine scheduled for the offense for which the violation was issued. It shall also advise that a warrant for the arrest of the person to whom the ticket was issued will be sought if such person fails to respond within the time limit.

19.055 - Offenses and fines.

Sec. 5. Identified offenses and fines for each shall be located in a Fine Schedule, in amounts set from time to time by resolution of the Village Council. Each violation shall be separate for purposes of penalties, and in the case of a continuing violation, each day shall be deemed a separate violation.

All public property and right-of-way is undesignated parking area unless paved and striped to accept vehicles. Unpaved areas must be signed as parking areas to be utilized for parking. Residents of single-family homes may park in un-designed parking areas in front of their residence when permitted by zoning. No vehicle shall park over or on any portion of a sidewalk or extend into any portion of the roadway.

Multiple offenses and fines issued to the same vehicle or driver for the same violation over a two-month period of time shall be doubled for each subsequent violation.

Sec. 2. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective 20 days upon its adoption.
