Trustee S. Newman supported by Trustee M. Rodriguez, moved the adoption of the following Ordinance:

**ORDINANCE NO. 205**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTIONS 40.103, 40.105 AND 40.108 OF  
THE COMPILED CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF MACKINAW CITY  
PERTAINING TO STREET AND ROAD NUMBERING**

The Village of Mackinaw City ordains:

Sec. 1. Amendment of Compiled Code. Sections 40.103, 40.105 and 40.108 of the Compiled Code of the Village of Mackinaw City (Ord. No. 126, Adopted July 18, 1996) are amended to read as follows:

Sec. 40.103. Definitions.

(a) The term "premises" shall mean any lot or parcel of land owned by any person, firm or corporation, public or private, improved with buildings, whether occupied or not, and to which a street or road number has been assigned.

(b) The term "street number" or "road number" shall mean any series of numbers assigned by the Village of Mackinaw City.

(c) The term "Village grid system" shall mean and refer to general east and west, and north and south division of the Village into four (4) grids to facilitate the assignment of identifying numbers, with the provisions of allowing one thousand (1,000) numbers per mile for each mile of distance from the base lines.

(d) The term "east and west bases" shall refer to a line drawn east and west to divide the Village into north and south grids.

East-West Base Line: Central Avenue from the Village limits to the Straits of Mackinac.

(e) The term "north and south base" shall refer to a line drawn north and south, to divide the Village into east and west grids.

North-South Base Line: Nicolet Street from the Village limits to the Straits of Mackinac.

(f) All "premises" shall be assigned a property identification number by the Cheboygan or Emmet County Equalization Department. Said identification numbers will be the basis for location on the Geographic Identification System (GIS) maps and be cross indexed to the

owner of the property and the available telephone numbers. The basic information required for a Central Emergency Response System (911) is to be provided.

(g) The term "interested party" shall refer to emergency services, such as police, fire, or any other emergency services, the owner, occupant, County or City department, public utilities or any other governmental agency.

(h) The term "street or road name" (hereafter, street) shall refer to any official name as recognized by government authority, and no such names street or road shall be changed without approval of the Village of Mackinaw City.

Sec. 40.105. Re-addressing.

The Village of Mackinaw City hereby reserves the right to re-address premises not in conformance with the provisions of this ordinance.

Sec. 40.108. Penalty.

(a) Any violation of this ordinance shall be a Tier 1 municipal civil infraction punishable by a fine, identified in a Fine Schedule, in an amount set from time to time by resolution of the Village Council. Each violation shall be separate for purposes of penalties, and in the case of a continuing violation, each day shall be deemed a separate violation.

(b) In addition to the imposition of the foregoing fines, penalties and other legal remedies, the Village of Mackinaw City may designate, may cause the proper posting of numbers, and the cost thereof assess against the owner of such premises.

Sec. 2. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect 20 days after its adoption, or upon publication, whichever occurs later.
