Ordinance Number 21-11-04

**AN ORDINANCE MODIFYING
CERTAIN SECTIONS OF TITLE 4, CHAPTER 1 OF
THE VILLAGE CODE TO MODIFY THE
STRUCTURE OF THE POLICE DEPARTMENT**

WHEREAS, the Village of Round Lake Beach is an Illinois municipal corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Illinois;

WHEREAS, the Village of Round Lake Beach is a home rule municipality as defined by Article VII of the Illinois Constitution;

WHEREAS, the Village of Round Lake Beach is authorized by the Illinois Municipal Code to provide police protection for the citizens of the Village of Round Lake Beach and to establish ranks for its police officers;

WHEREAS, the Village Board of the Village of Round Lake Beach has determined it is in the best interests of the Village to restructure the police department notwithstanding any provision to the contrary in the Board of Fire and Police Commissioners Act as provided herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Round Lake Beach, Lake County, Illinois, in the exercise of its home rule powers as follows:

SECTION 1: The above-stated recitals are incorporated by this reference.

SECTION 2: Sections 4-1-1, A, of the Village Code is hereby repealed and replaced as follows:

Sec. 4-1-1. Department created; regulations adopted.

A. *Members.* There is hereby continued, created and established an executive department of the village, to be known as the police department. The police department shall consist of one chief of police, up to two deputy chiefs, up to four commanders, up to four sergeants, up to 35 patrol officers, up to two community service officers, and any other special officers and employees as may be authorized by the village board from time-to-time.

SECTION 3: All other previous ordinances establishing or modifying the structure of the police department are hereby expressly repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 4: If any section, paragraph, clause, or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any of the other provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from after its passage and approval.
