Ordinance: ORD-006-25

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROWLETT, TEXAS AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES BY AMENDING CHAPTER 66 “TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES,” ARTICLE II “SPECIFIC STREET REGULATIONS,” DIVISION 4 “STOPPING, STANDING, PARKING” BY REPEALING IN ITS ENTIRETY SECTION 66-105 “PARKING PROHIBITED IN DART PUBLIC PARKING LOT”; PROVIDING A REPEALING CLAUSE; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City and Dallas Area Rapid Transit (“DART”) have entered into an agreement by which the City’s residents are allowed to park motor vehicles in the DART public parking lot situated at 5000 Martin Drive; and

WHEREAS, in view of that agreement, the City Council for the City of Rowlett finds that it serves the general welfare and is in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Rowlett to repeal section 66-105 of the Code of Ordinances “Parking prohibited in DART public parking lot” in its entirety;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROWLETT, TEXAS THAT:

SECTION 1: The Code of Ordinances of the City of Rowlett, Texas is amended by amending Chapter 66 “Traffic and Vehicles,” Article II “Specific Street Regulations,” Division 4 “Stopping, Standing, Parking” by repealing in its entirety section 66-105 “Parking prohibited in DART public parking lot.”

SECTION 2: All provisions of the ordinances of the City of Rowlett in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance be, and the same are hereby, repealed, and all other provisions of the ordinances of the City of Rowlett not in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.


SECTION 3: Should any sentence, paragraph, subdivision, clause, phrase or section of this ordinance be adjudged or held to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole, or any part or provision thereof other than the part so decided to be invalid, illegal or unconstitutional, and shall not affect the validity of the Code of Ordinances as a whole.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and the publication of the caption, as the law and charter in such cases provide.
