ORDINANCE NO. 23-1024

AN ORDINANCE AMMENDING SECTION 27 of CHAPTER 1 of TITLE 10, MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC FOR THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF VERONA

SECTION 10-1-27

The Common Council of the City of Verona, Dane County, Wisconsin, does ordain that Sections 10-1-27(a)(100), 10-1-27(a)(101), 10-1-27(a)(102), 10-1-27(a)(103), 10-1-27(a)(104), 10-1-27(a)(105), 10-1-27(a)(106), of the Code or Ordinances of the City of Verona are created to read as follows (language added/language deleted):

Sec. 10-1-27 Parking Prohibited Zones

- (a) Parking Prohibited at All Times. No person shall park, stop or leave standing any vehicle upon any of the following highways or parts of highways:
 - (100) On the north side of Prairie Heights Drive, from the intersection with New Age Circle extending west for a distance of twenty-five (25) feet.
 - (101) On the north side of Prairie Heights Drive, from the intersection with New Age Way extending east for a distance of twenty-five (25) feet.
 - (102) On the north side of Prairie Heights Drive, from the intersection with New Age Way extending west for a distance of twenty-five (25) feet.
 - (103) On the south side of Prairie Heights Drive, from the eastern driveway of 411 Prairie Heights drive extending east for a distance of twenty-five (25) feet.
 - (104) On the south side of Prairie Heights Drive, from the eastern driveway of 411 Prairie Heights drive extending west for a distance of twenty-five (25) feet.
 - (105) On the south side of Prairie Heights Drive, from the western driveway of 411 Prairie Heights drive extending east for a distance of twenty-five (25) feet.
 - (106) On the south side of Prairie Heights Drive, from the western driveway of 411 Prairie Heights drive extending west for a distance of twenty-five (25) feet.

All other sections shall remain as previously adopted.
