## ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 34, LAW ENFORCEMENT, SEC. 34-4 - RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT FOR MARSHAL AND DEPUTY MARSHAL; SEC. 34-5 (b) PARKING RESTRICTION DURING SNOW REMOVAL; SEC. 34-5 (b) IMPOUND RELEASE CHARGE;

WHEREAS, the Hebron Town Council has adopted Chapter 34, Law Enforcement to its

Code of Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, the Hebron Town Council feels that the following paragraphs of said Ordinance

should be modified;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Hebron Town Council that Sec.34-4 - Residency Requirement for Marshal and Deputy Marshals be deleted in its entity as it is defined by State Code.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Hebron Town Council that Sec. 34-5 (b) Parking restrictions during snow removal, shall be moved to Sec. 62-164.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Hebron Town Council that Sec. 34-5 (b), Impound release charge, shall be moved to Sec. 62-104 and shall read as follows:

(b) Impound release charge

- (1) The town and the town police department have determined that here is an actual average administrative cost to release vehicles which have been impounded by the police department. Such average costs include manpower, supplies, legal, and telephone. Such costs total an average of \$100.00 per release.
- (2) An impound release change of \$100.00 per vehicle shall be paid by an automobile owner or his agent, to the town, as an average processing cost to release said vehicle from impound.

BE IT FINALLY ORDAINED by the Hebron Town Council that this Ordinance No. 2018-
