ORDINANCE

The Common Council of the City of Sun Prairie, Dane County, Wisconsin, hereby ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. That Sections of 10.12.010 is hereby repealed and recreated as follows: (Additions are noted by underline, deletions are noted by ~~overstrike~~.)

10.12.010 – Speed Limits.

- A. State Speed Limits Adopted. The provisions of Sections 346.57, 346.58, and 346.59, Wisconsin Statutes, relating to the maximum and minimum speed of vehicles are adopted as part of this section as if fully set forth herein, except as specified by this section pursuant to Section 349.11(3)(c), Wisconsin Statutes, where the common council has determined that the statutory speed limits are unreasonable, unsafe and imprudent and has modified such limits.
- B. Speed Limits Increased. The speed limits are increased as hereinafter set forth in this subsection upon the following street or portions thereof between the limits designated:
 - 1. Reserved.
 - 2. Reserved.
 - 3. Thirty-five (35) miles per hour from the city limits on North Bristol Street south to a point two hundred (200) feet north of the intersection of Tower Drive.
 - 4. Thirty-five (35) miles per hour on Windsor Street from the intersection with Davison Drive to North Grand Avenue (CTH "C").
 - 5. Thirty-five (35) miles per hour on Wilburn Road from Columbus Street to the city limits.
 - 6. Thirty-five (35) miles per hour on Stone Quarry Road from Columbus Street east to the city limits.
 - 7. Thirty-five (35) miles per hour on Progress Way in its entirety.
 - 8. Reserved.
 - 9. Thirty-five (35) miles per hour on Hoepker Road from CTH "C" west to the intersection of Portage Road and Rattman Road.
 - 10. Forty (40) miles per hour on Grand Avenue in its entirety (or CTH "C" from STH 19 to STH 151).
 - 11. Reserved.

12. ~~Thirty (30) miles per hour on Grove Street from Sanibel Lane to the most southern city limit which is one thousand seven hundred fifty (1,750) feet south of Sanibel Lane. Reserved.~~

SECTION 2. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon passage and publication as provided by law.
