**ORDINANCE CREATING

ORDINANCE

The Common Council of the City of Sun Prairie, Dane County, Wisconsin, hereby ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. That Section 6.04.055 is hereby created as follows:

Section 6.04.055 Chicken-keeping licenses.

1. The keeping of chickens in the City of Sun Prairie requires the granting of a special use permit per Section 17.16.140 prior to the construction of a coop/enclosure. In addition, a chicken-keeping license shall be obtained from the City Clerk's Office prior to the acquisition of any chickens. Said license shall be renewed annually in order to maintain the right to keep chickens.

2. The license year for the keeping of chickens shall commence on January 1 and end on December 31 each year. Applications for the annual renewal of chicken keeping licenses shall be filed with the City Clerk on a form provided by the City, along with a non-refundable license fee of \$15.

3. A late fee of five dollars (\$5) per-month shall be collected from any licensee that files for renewal after January 1 in any year.

4. The holder of a chicken keeping license agrees to allow the city to enter and inspect the premises upon reasonable notice to assess compliance with the standards contained in Section 17.16.140. The City Clerk shall not renew any license of an operator that does not, within a reasonable timeframe, correct any deficiencies identified upon written notice from the city.

SECTION 2. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon passage and publication as provided by law.
