ORDINANCE

The Common Council of the City of Sun Prairie, Dane County, Wisconsin, hereby ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. That Chapter 10.16 is hereby repealed and recreated as follows: (Additions are noted by underline, deletions are noted by overstrike.)

Chapter 10.16 – PARKING REGULATIONS GENERALLY

10.16.030 - Stopping or parking prohibited in certain specified places.

- A. Parking Prohibited. No person shall stop, park or leave standing any vehicle, whether attended or unattended and whether temporarily or otherwise, in any of the following places:
1. Within an intersection;
 2. On a crosswalk;
 3. Within a designated bicycle lane;
 4. On a sidewalk or terrace area, except when parking in such place is clearly indicated by official traffic signs or markers or parking meters. "Terrace or sidewalk area" means that area between the sidewalk and the nearest curb line running parallel or generally parallel thereto or in the absence of a sidewalk ten (10) feet beyond the curb line;
 5. Alongside or opposite any highway excavation or obstruction when such stopping or standing would obstruct traffic or when pedestrian traffic would be required to travel in the roadway;
 6. On the roadway side of any parked vehicle unless double parking is clearly indicated by official traffic signs or markers;
 7. Within twenty (20) feet of the driveway entrance to a fire station;
 8. Upon any portion of a highway where and at the time when stopping or standing is prohibited by official traffic signs indicating the prohibition of any stopping or standing;
 9. In any place or manner so as to obstruct, block or impede traffic;
 10. Within ten (10) feet of a fire hydrant, unless a greater distance is indicated by an official traffic sign;
 11. Upon any portion of a highway where and at the time when parking is prohibited, limited or restricted by official traffic signs;
 12. Upon any bridge;
 13. Upon any street or highway within the city limits any vehicle which faces a direction different from the direction of normal traffic flow for the lane of traffic in which such vehicle is stopped or standing;
 14. Upon any terrace or sidewalk in the city at any time;
 15. Within fifty (50) feet of the nearest rail of a railroad crossing.
 16. In, along, or in front of any public transit bus stop that has been officially designated and appropriately signed as such. Public transit vehicles, such as a bus or shared-ride taxi, may park along or in front of the aforementioned public transit bus stops in association with the provision of service.
- B. Parking in Driveways. No person shall park or leave standing any motor vehicle in any private driveway without the permission of the owner or lessee of the property upon which such driveway is located, whether

or not such driveway is posted to limit or restrict parking.

- C. Parking Vehicle for Repair or to Display for Sale Prohibited. No person shall stand or park a vehicle on any street, alley, public right-of-way or municipal parking lot in the city for the purpose of repairing such vehicle, or to display such vehicle for sale.
- D. Parking Vehicle for Use as Living Quarters or Residence Prohibited. Except as allowed by other provisions of this code of ordinances, no person shall stand or park a vehicle on any street, alley, public right -of-way or municipal parking lot in the city while utilizing such vehicle as a personal living quarters or a residence for any length of time.

SECTION 2. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon passage and publication as provided by law.
