

**CITY OF ANNA MARIA
ORDINANCE NO. 11-721**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ANNA MARIA, FLORIDA, AMENDING ORDINANCE 08-696 AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCES 05-630, 05-646 AND 06-658 PERTAINING TO TRAFFIC REGULATIONS FOR THE PUBLIC ROADS AND RIGHTS-OF-WAY WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF ANNA MARIA; PROVIDING FOR FINDINGS OF FACT; PROVIDING FOR AMENDMENT TO THE PARKING , STOPPING, AND STANDING REGULATIONS OF THE CITY OF ANNA MARIA; PROVIDING FOR THE SCHEDULE OF PARKING REGULATIONS FOR NORTH BAY BOULEVARD, ELM AVENUE AND GULF DRIVE; PROVIDING FOR ONE-WAY TRAFFIC ON A PORTION OF PALM AVENUE AND MAXINE PLACE; PROVIDING FOR THE RELOCATION OF STOP SIGNS FOR THE NORTH BAY BOULEVARD BRIDGE; PROVIDING FOR THE INSTALLATION OF STOP SIGNS ON JACARANDA ROAD AT ROSE STREET AND ON NORTH BAY BOULEVARD AT LAKEVIEW DRIVE; PROVIDING FOR THE DELETION OF SECTION 2 OF ORDINANCE 08-696 PERTAINING TO CRESCENT DRIVE BRIDGE STOP SIGNS; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Anna Maria is authorized to regulate public roads and rights-of-way and the traffic thereon within its corporate boundaries pursuant to the Florida Constitution, Florida Statutes, and the City Charter; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the city of Anna Maria approved Ordinances 05-630, 05-646 , 06-658 and 08-696 regarding parking on public rights-of-way and similar traffic regulation issues within the City ; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission has determined that certain parking and traffic regulations established or amended by Ordinances 05-630, 05-646, 06-568 and 08-686 are in need of amendments; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission has determined that the City regulations governing areas of prohibited parking on North Bay Boulevard are in need of amendment; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission has determined that the areas for alternative parking on Elm Avenue and prohibited parking on Gulf Drive needs to be better defined; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission recognizes a one way street pattern for a portion of Palm Avenue and Maxine Place; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission has determined that the City regulations governing the location of stop signs on the North Bay Boulevard Bridge are in need of amendment; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission has determined that the installation of stops signs on Jacaranda Road at Rose Street increases the safety for the motoring public; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission has determined that the Crescent Avenue Bridge stop signs are in need of removal; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds this ordinance is other wise in the best public health, safety, and welfare.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City Commission of the City of Anna Maria, as follows:

Section One. Findings of Fact

The above "whereas" clauses are deemed findings of fact.

Section Two. Amendment to the areas of Parking on North Bay Boulevard.

Schedule B of Ordinance 05-630 as amended by Ordinance 05-646 and Ordinance 06-658, is hereby amended by adding all language shown as underscored and deleting all language shown as strikethrough, so as to read in its entirety as follows:

2. From Pine Ave to the abutment of Bridge no. 135000, on the westerly side, except parking is authorized on the westerly side, beginning 112 feet from Pine Ave ~~30 feet from the base of the stop sign at Pine Ave and North Bay Boulevard~~ for a distance of ~~141~~ 223 feet, in a northerly direction.

Section Three. Amendment to the areas of Parking for Elm Avenue and Gulf Drive.

Schedule B of Ordinance 05-630 as amended by Ordinance 05-646 and Ordinance 06-658, is hereby amended by adding all language shown as underscored and deleting all language shown as strikethrough, so as to read in its entirety as follows:

43- Beginning December 1, 2005, alternate side of the street parking allowed, beginning with odd numbers and changed on a yearly basis, from North Shore Drive, in a westerly direction, to ~~60 feet east of the Gulf Drive western end of the pavement,~~ . Parking is

prohibited on both sides of Elm Avenue, from Gulf Drive, in a westerly direction, to the end of the road.

Section Four. Codifying one way traffic for portions of Palm Avenue and Maxine Place.

Ordinance 08-696 is hereby amended by adding all language shown as underscored , so as to read in its entirety as follows:

One Way Street- Palm Avenue beginning at the intersection of Crescent Avenue proceeding to and in the direction of Maxine Place and along Maxine Place beginning at the intersection of Palm Avenue proceeding to and in the direction of Magnolia Avenue.

Section Five. Amendment to the North Bay Bridge Stop Signs.

Section 1 of Ordinance 08-696, is hereby amended by adding all language shown as underscored and deleting all language shown as strikethrough, so as to read in its entirety as follows:

The City Commission hereby authorizes the placement of a stop signs on the southern approach ~~and~~ requiring all traffic to stop prior to crossing the North Bay Bridge. All traffic shall stop where the approach slope of the bridge intersects the level surface of North Bay Boulevard.

Section Six Amendment to the Intersections with Stop Signs.

Ordinance 08-696, is hereby amended is hereby amended by adding all language shown as underscored, so as to read in its entirety as follows:

The City Commission hereby authorizes the placement of stop signs on Jacaranda Road at the intersection of Rose Street and on North Bay Boulevard at the intersection of Lakeview Drive.

Section Seven. Deletion of the requirement for Stop Signs at the Crescent Drive Bridge.

Section 2 of Ordinance 08-696, is hereby amended is hereby amended by deleting all language shown as strikethrough, so as to read in its entirety as follows:

~~Crescent Drive Bridge Stops—The City Commission hereby authorizes the placement of stop signs and requiring all traffic to stop prior to crossing the Crescent Avenue Bridge. All traffic shall stop where the approach slope of the bridge intersects the level surface of Crescent Street.~~

Section Five Repeal of Ordinance.


This Ordinance hereby repeals all Ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith to the extent of such conflict.

Section Seventeen. Severability. If any section, sub-section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this Ordinance shall be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, then such invalidity shall not effect the remaining portions hereof.

Section Sixteen. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be effective upon adoption by the City Commission and approval by the Mayor in accordance with the Charter of the City of Anna Maria
