ORDINANCE NO. 538

ORDINANCE SETTING THE SALARY OF THE CHAIR AND MEMBERS OF THE SHELBY COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION. THIS ITEM REQUIRES AN EXPENDITURE OF \$45,000.00 FROM THE FISCAL YEAR (FY) 2023 EDUCATION FUND. SPONSORED BY COMMISSIONER EDDIE S. JONES, JR.

WHEREAS, Under the authority of Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-2-202(d), the Board of Shelby County Commissioners is authorized to fix the salary of the members of the Shelby County Board of Education; and

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners is responsible for setting the salary of the members of the Shelby County Board of Education, also known as the Memphis Shelby County Board of Education; and

WHEREAS, The current annual salaries for the above-captioned elected officials are:

Chair	\$26,000.00
All other members	\$25,000.00

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SHELBY COUNTY, TENNESSEE, That the salary of the Chair of the Memphis Shelby County Board of Education is hereby set at \$31,000.00 per annum, and the salary of the other members of the Board of Education is set at \$30,000.00 per annum, payable in monthly installments beginning on July 1, 2022.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That the FY 2023 Education Fund is hereby amended to allocate and appropriate \$45,000.00 for the purposes stated herein.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That the Mayor and Director of Administration and Finance are hereby approved to take the action(s) necessary to carry out the legislative intent herein.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That the various sections, words, and phrases of this Ordinance are severable, and that any portion declared unlawful shall not affect the remaining portions.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That the adoption of this Ordinance represents an increase in the county school board members' salary thus requiring a two-thirds (2/3rd) vote of the Board of County Commissioners.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance shall become effective in accordance with the Shelby County Charter, Article II, Section 2.06(C), the public welfare requiring same.
