A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NEPTUNE BEACH, FLORIDA CHAPTER 17 SALES ADDING SECTION 17-48 FOOD TRUCKS AT SPECIAL EVENTS WHICH ALLOWS FOR FOOD TRUCKS TO BE PERMITTED AT SPECIAL EVENTS UPON APPROVAL BY THE CITY MANAGER AND AMENDING CHAPTER 21 TAXATION SECTION 21-32 LOCAL BUSINESS TAX RECEIPT SCHEDULE PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Whereas, the City Council of the City of Neptune Beach, Florida has determined that it is appropriate to allow food trucks at special events under certain conditions as set forth below in Section 1.

Now, Therefore, be it ordained by the City Council of Neptune Beach, Florida:

Section 1. Sec. 17-48. Food Trucks at Special Events to be added as follows:

Food Trucks or similar mobile kitchens may be permitted by the City Manager at private special events, including catering, under the following rules:

1. Submittal of a completed and approved application form by the property owner or sponsor of the private special event with the property owner's written permission.
2. Proof of liability insurance held by the Food Truck owner for at least \$1,000,000.00.
3. Proof of inspection by the Duval County Health Department of the Food Truck within the last six months
4. The Food Truck owner must have a valid Neptune Beach Business Tax Receipt.
5. The Food Truck will not be allowed to operate within the Central Business District, the Beach and Residential Districts (only property owner sponsored catering is allowed in the residential district) unless approved by the City Council.
6. The Food Truck at a private special event may be closed by the Police Department or the Building Official for safety issues, violation of these rules or violation of other city ordinances.
7. The Food Truck may only operate at the private special event during the approved hours of the event, including set-up and take down times.
8. Catering is defined as where a property owner hosting an private special event pays the Food Truck owner for the service and no individual sales takes place.
9. A Food Truck shall be defined as a vehicle, trailer or other similar mobile food unit equipped with facilities for cooking and/or preparing and selling food at a private special event.
- 9-10. A private special event shall be defined as an occasional or periodic gathering hosted, or sponsored or authorized by a property owner. The frequency and uniqueness of the proposed event shall be considered by the City Manager.

Section 2. Sec. 21-32 Local Business tax receipt schedule to be amended as follows

Service Establishments

Food Trucks\$65.00.

Section 3. The Ordinance shall become effective on after passage by the City Council.
