

## **ORDINANCE NO. 2020-14**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, OF MIAMI-DADE FLORIDA, ADOPTING THE FINAL MILLAGE RATE OF 2.2350 FOR THE VILLAGE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING OCTOBER 1, 2020, THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2021, PURSUANT TO SECTION 200.065, FLORIDA STATUTES; PROVIDING FOR NOTICE; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE. (*Sponsored by Administration*)**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 200.065, Florida Statutes, the Miami-Dade County Property Appraiser ("Property Appraiser") has certified the gross taxable value as \$3,199,561,967 within the Village of Palmetto Bay for the year 2020 which includes all real and personal property within the Village; and,

**WHEREAS**, on July 13, 2020, the Village Council adopted Resolution No. 2020-69 determining the proposed maximum millage rate of 2.2350 for the fiscal year commencing October 1, 2020 and further scheduling two public hearings on the millage rate as required by Section 200.065, Florida Statutes, to be held on Monday, September 14, 2020 at 7:00 p.m. and on Wednesday, September 23, 2020 at 7:00 p.m., at the Village of Palmetto Bay Municipal Center, 9705 E Hibiscus Street, Palmetto Bay, FL 33157; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Village Council and the Village Manager have reviewed the Tentative Fiscal Year 2020-2021 budget for the Village and have considered an estimate of the necessary expenditures contemplated for in the budget and have determined that the levy set forth below provides the necessary funds for such expenditures.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY OF MIAMI DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by reference.

**Section 2.** The Fiscal Year 2020-2021 Tentative operating millage rate for the Village of Palmetto Bay is 2.2350 mills, which is higher than the rolled back rate of 2.1183 mills by 5.51%.

**Section 3.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are repealed.

**Section 4.** If any section, clause, sentence, or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, the holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

**Section 5.** This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon enactment.
