

ORDINANCE NO. 0-548-13

**To Amend Sections 6-21, 6-45, 6-100 and 6-104 of the Code of the
City of Jacksonville, Alabama**

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Jacksonville, Alabama, as follows:

SECTION 1.

Section 6-21 of the Code of the City of Jacksonville, Alabama, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"(a) The following codes are hereby adopted by reference as though they were herein fully set forth:

Minimum setback from the public streets shall be at a distance determined by the city engineer and allow emergency vehicles the ability to safely operate the lock box or panel."

- (b) When reference is made within said codes to the duties of certain officials named therein, that designated official of the city who has duties corresponding to those of the named official in said code shall be deemed to be the responsible official insofar as enforcing the provisions of said code are concerned. "

SECTION 2.

Section 6-45 of the Code of the City of Jacksonville, Alabama, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Except as provided in section 6-48, no person shall work as an electrician in the city unless he holds a city license and a license issued upon examination pursuant to Code of Ala. 1975, title 34, ch. 36 (Code of Ala. 1975, § 34-36-1 et seq.)"

SECTION 3.

Section 6-100 of the Code of the City of Jacksonville, Alabama, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"No person shall do any electrical work as an electrician or electrical contractor in the city without first obtaining a permit as required by law to do such work."

SECTION 4.

Section 6-104 of the Code of the City of Jacksonville, Alabama, is hereby amended

to read as follows:

"The fees for permits and inspections shall be as established by the City Council."

SECTION 5.

If any provision, clause, sentence, or paragraph of this Ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstances shall be held invalid, that invalidity shall not affect the other provisions of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

SECTION 6:

This ordinance shall become effective May 1, 2013 after its publication as required by law.
