**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 18, TAXATION, ARTICLE VI,
REAL ESTATE TRANSFER TAX, SECTION 18-107, TAX STAMPS, OF
THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF ALSIP**

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BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Village of Alsip, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter 18, Taxation, Article VI, Real Estate Transfer Tax, Section 18-107(a) & (b)(1), Tax Stamps, to provide as follows:

- (a) The village clerk shall cause to be printed, in such form and quantities and in such denominations as he or she may from time to time determine, real estate transfer tax stamps for the purpose of paying tax imposed by this article. The Village also may appoint one or more agents to sell the stamps.
- (b) (1) The village clerk from time to time may provide for the issuance and exclusive use of tax stamps of a new design and forbid the use of stamps of any prior design. After the effective date of the change, it shall be unlawful for any person to pay the tax imposed by this article.

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Section 2. Home Rule. This ordinance is enacted pursuant to the home rule powers of the Village of Alsip.

Section 3. Severability. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any of the other provisions of this ordinance.


Section 4. Repealer. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as they conflict herewith.

Section 5. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be effective retroactive to July 1, 2020 after passage and approval as provided by law.


