Ordinance No. 023536 Council Bill No. B 94-18

AN ORDINANCE

extending the corporate limits of the City of Columbia, Missouri, by annexing property located generally southeast of the intersection of I-70 Drive SW and Strawn Road (840 N. Strawn Road); directing the City Clerk to give notice of the annexation; placing the property annexed in District R-1 (One-Family Dwelling District); and fixing the time when this ordinance shall become effective.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby finds that a verified petition was filed with the City on January 16, 2018, requesting the annexation of land which is contiguous and compact to the existing corporate limits of the City and which is described in Section 4 of this ordinance. The petition was signed by Mike Matthes, in his capacity as the City Manager for the City of Columbia, Missouri, the sole owner of the fee interest of record in the land proposed to be annexed. A public hearing was held concerning this matter on May 7, 2018. Notice of this hearing was published more than seven days prior to the hearing in a newspaper of general circulation qualified to publish legal matters. At the public hearing all interested persons, corporations and political subdivisions were permitted to present evidence regarding the proposed annexation.

SECTION 2. The Council determines that the annexation is reasonable and necessary to the proper development of the City and that the City has the ability to furnish normal municipal services to the area to be annexed within a reasonable time.

SECTION 3. The Council determines that no written objection to the proposed annexation has been filed within fourteen days after the public hearing.

SECTION 4. The City Council hereby extends the city limits by annexing the land described in Section 1-11.41 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia, Missouri, which is hereby added to Chapter 1 of the City Code and which reads as follows:

Section 1-11.41. May, 2018 Extension of Corporate Limits.

The corporate limits of the City of Columbia shall include the following land:

A tract of land containing 46.95 acres, more or less, located in the Northeast Quarter (NE ¼) of Section Eight (8), Township Forty-eight (48) North, Range Thirteen (13) west, of the Fifth (5th) Principal Meridian, in Boone County, Missouri, being a part of Tracts One (1) and Two (2) of Boone County Survey No. 7602, and being shown and described by the survey thereof recorded July 22, 1994 as Document No. 16070 in Book 1096, Page 183, Records of Boone County, Missouri.

And also a tract of land located in the Northeast Quarter (NE ¼) of Section Eight (8), Township Forty-eight (48) North, Range Thirteen (13) West, of the Fifth (5th) Principal Meridian, in Boone County, Missouri, being shown and described as Tract Two (2) of Boone County Survey No. 7602, EXCEPTING therefrom that part located within the survey recorded July 22, 1994 as Document No. 16070 in Book 1096, Page 183, Records of Boone County, Missouri, and ALSO EXCEPTING therefrom that part located within the public road right-of-way.

SECTION 5. The City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to cause three certified copies of this ordinance to be filed with the Clerk of Boone County, Missouri and three certified copies with the Assessor of Boone County, Missouri. The City Clerk is further authorized and directed to forward to the Missouri Department of Revenue, by registered or certified mail, a certified copy of this ordinance and a map of the City clearly showing the area annexed to the City.


SECTION 6. The property described in Section 4 is in the Second Ward.

SECTION 7. The "Official Zoning Map of the City of Columbia, Missouri" established and adopted by Section 29-1.4 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia, Missouri, is hereby amended so that the property described in Section 4 will be zoned and become a part of District R-1 (One-Family Dwelling District).

SECTION 8. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
