

Ordinance 730

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF HURRICANE TO FILE  
AN APPLICATION AND PLAN PURSUANT TO THE WEST VIRGINIA  
MUNICIPAL HOME RULE PROGRAM AS ESTABLISHED BY  
WEST VIRGINIA CODE 8-1-5a; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY  
MANAGER TO SIGN THE APPLICATION AND ALL DOCUMENTS AND  
SUBMISSIONS TO BE FILED PURSUANT THERETO; AND  
AUTHORIZING THE CITY RECORDER TO CERTIFY THIS ORDINANCE  
FOR SUBMISSION WITH THE APPLICATION**

WHEREAS, the West Virginia Legislature duly adopted Senate Bill No. 4 establishing the Municipal Home Rule Program as a permanent program created pursuant to the provisions of West Virginia Code 8-1-5a; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Hurricane is an eligible municipality to participate in such program; and,

WHEREAS, eligible municipalities may submit a written plan and application pursuant to the provisions of said program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hurricane has caused to be prepared an application and plan, together with attachments and affidavits; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Hurricane has caused to be published a notice as required by law and has conducted a public hearing pursuant to such notice.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Hurricane, Putnam County, West Virginia, as follows:

1. That the City of Hurricane submit an application to participate in the Municipal Home Rule Program established by the West Virginia Legislature as set forth in West

Virginia Code 8-1-5a, together with all affidavits and attachments attached thereto,  
all in the form attached to this Ordinance and incorporated herein.

2. That the Mayor and City Manager be and they are hereby authorized to execute on  
behalf of the City the application and all associated documents submitted therewith  
as required by West Virginia Code 8-1-5a.
3. That the Recorder be and she is hereby authorized to certify this Ordinance and the  
manner of its adoption for submission with the application.
