

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF COWETA COUNTY, GEORGIA TO AMEND CHAPTER 6. ALCOHOL, ARTICLE II. LICENSING OF THE COWETA COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Coweta County, Georgia regulates the sale of alcohol within the county; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Coweta County, Georgia has determined that it is in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the public to amend the residency requirement for a license representative to reside in the State of Georgia.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Coweta County, Georgia and it is hereby ordained by the Authority of the same that Chapter 6. Alcohol, Article II. Licensing, Section 6-42. Required Residency, License Representative of the Coweta County Code of Ordinances be amended as follows:

Delete: Chapter 6. Alcohol, Article II. Licensing, Section 6-42. Required Residency, License Representative in its entirety and replace with the following:

“ For all licenses issued under this chapter, the licensee must designate a license representative who has been a resident of the State of Georgia for twelve months prior to filing of the application and shall continue to be a resident of the State of Georgia while acting as the license representative. In addition, the license representative shall be a manager of the business who is a full-time employee of the business and shall be required to assume an active role in the day-to-day operations of the business.”

All other provisions of Chapter 6. Businesses shall remain in full force and effect.
