ORDINANCE NO. 3195

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 54.102(b) OF THE NORTH RICHLAND HILLS CODE OF ORDINANCES; ALTERING THE PRIMA FACIA SPEED LIMITS ESTABLISHED FOR VEHICLES UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THE TRANSPORTATION CODE, CHAPTER 545, SECTION 545.356. UPON THE BASIS OF AN ENGINEERING AND **TRAFFIC INVESTIFATION UPON** CERTAIN **STREETS** HIGHWAYS, OR PARTS THEROF, WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF NORTH RICHLAND HILLS AS SET OUT IN THIS ORDINANCE: ESTABLISHING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION: PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, The Texas Transportation Code, Chapter 545, Paragraph 545.356, provides that whenever the governing body of the City shall determine upon the basis of an engineering and traffic investigation that any prima facie speed therein set forth is greater or less than is reasonable or safe under the conditions found to exist at any intersection or other place or upon any part of a street or highway, with the City taking into consideration the width and condition of the pavement and other circumstances on such portion of said street or highway, as well as the usual traffic thereon, said governing body may determine and declare a reasonable and safe prima facie speed limit thereat or thereon, said governing body may determine and declare a reasonable and safe prima facie speed limit thereat or thereon by the passage of an ordinance, which shall be effective when appropriate signs giving notice thereof are erected at such intersection or other place or part of the street of highway;

WHEREAS, WHEREAS, the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDot) has performed such engineering and traffic investigation for Precinct Line Road (FM 3029) and has recommended that posted speed limits be changed as herein established; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH RICHLAND HILLS, TEXAS:

Section 1: THAT Section 54.102(b) of the North Richland Hills Code of Ordinances be amended to read as follows:

"Sec. 54-102. Certain public streets

- (a) ...
- (b) Speed limits on specific streets. Upon the basis of an engineering and traffic investigation made as authorized by the provisions of V.T.C.A., Transportation

Code § 545.351 et seq., Uniform Act Regulating Traffic on Highways, the following prima facie speed limits indicated for vehicles are hereby determined and declared to be reasonable and safe, and such speed limits are hereby fixed at the rate of speed indicated for vehicles traveling upon the named streets and highways, or parts thereof, described as follows:

 Amundson Drive from its intersection with Main Street northeast parallel 35mph with the railroad right-of-way to its intersection with Eden Road and then east to its intersection with Precinct Line Road:
