

ORDINANCE NO. 14-08

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE ELKHORN MUNICIPAL
CODE AT CHAPTER 7

WHEREAS, 2013 Wisconsin Act 377 provides that there is no weight limitation per axle, or group of axles for Category "B" implements of husbandry as defined in Sec. 340.0(24)(a)1.b, but does apply gross vehicle limitations to those vehicles, and

WHEREAS, Wis. Stats 348.15(9)(f) authorizes the municipality or county to require compliance with the axle weight limitations established under Wis. Stats 348.15(3)(g) for Category "B" implements of husbandry as defined in Sec. 340.0(24)(a)1.b on all roadways under its jurisdiction.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Common Council of the City of Elkhorn that Section 7.23 of Elkhorn Municipal Code be created to read as follows:

Section 7.23 Statutory Weight Limits For Implements Of Husbandry

7.23.1 Pursuant to Wis. Stats Section 348.15(9)(f), all implements of husbandry operating within the City of Elkhorn (including Category "B" implements of husbandry) may not exceed the statutory weight and length limits imposed by Wis. Stats Section 348.15(3)(g).


7.23.2 Vehicles exceeding the length and/or weight limitations on roadways under the jurisdiction of the City may apply for a no-fee permit from the City Department of Public Works.

7.23.3 In the event that an application for a no-fee permit is made for a Category "B" implement of husbandry, the City shall provide an approved alternate route, which may include highways that not under the City's jurisdiction of prior approval has been granted by the jurisdiction over the alternate route not under the City's jurisdiction.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that the existing Sections **7.23**, **7.24**, and **7.25** shall be renumbered as **7.24**, **7.25**, and **7.26** respectively.

This ordinance shall be in force from and after its introduction and publication as provided by statutes.
