**ORDINANCE NO. 023 -2024**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE MONROE COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS AMENDING SECTION 19-4 OF THE MONROE COUNTY CODE PROVIDING FOR REVISED TOLL RATES AND TOLL-BY-PLATE RATES; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF ALL ORDINANCES INCONSISTENT HERewith; PROVIDING FOR INCORPORATION INTO THE MONROE COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners (BOCC) after discussion and public input at its March 21, 2018 meeting in Key Largo set the toll rate for the Card Sound Road at \$.75 per axle for 2-axle vehicles; \$1.00 per axle for vehicles with greater than 2-axles to be effective upon implementation of the all-electronic tolling (AET) system and directed for the rate to be adjusted annually in accordance with the Consumer Price Index (CPI); and

**WHEREAS**, the BOCC adopted *Ordinance No. 008-2018*, which increased the rates and became effective upon the completion of the all-electronic tolling (AET) system on Card Sound Road; and

**WHEREAS**, the BOCC adopted *Ordinance No. 032-2019*, which increased the toll rates by 2.1% in accordance with the Bureau of Labor Statistics Consumer Price Index for all items less food and energy for Fiscal Year 20 (effective October 1, 2019); and

**WHEREAS**, the BOCC adopted *Ordinance No. 028-2020*, which increased the toll rates by 1.2% in accordance with the Bureau of Labor Statistics Consumer Price Index for all items less food and energy for Fiscal Year 2021 (effective October 1, 2020); and

**WHEREAS**, the BOCC adopted *Ordinance No. 015-2021*, which increased the toll rates by 1.6% in accordance with the Bureau of Labor Statistics Consumer Price Index for all items less food and energy for Fiscal Year 2022 (effective October 1, 2021); and

**WHEREAS**, the BOCC adopted *Ordinance No. 007-2022*, which increased the toll rates by 8.5% in accordance with the Bureau of Labor Statistics Consumer Price Index for all items less food and energy for Fiscal Year 2023 (effective October 1, 2022); and

**WHEREAS** due to increased administrative cost for the processing and collection of toll-by-plate customers, a separate toll-by-plate rate was added for these customers to offset the higher administrative cost effective October 1, 2022; and

**WHEREAS**, the BOCC adopted Ordinance No.014-2023 which increased the toll rates by 5% rounded to the nearest dollars for consistency at each per axle and toll-by-plate rates; and

**WHEREAS**, the toll rates are being revised as set forth below pursuant to the BOCC's direction to adjust the rates annually in accordance with the Bureau of Labor Statistics Consumer Price Index for all items less food and energy, which rose 3.5% over the last 12-months;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MONROE COUNTY, FLORIDA:**

**SECTION 1:** Section 19-4(b)(1) shall be amended to read as follows (added text noted in underlined text and deleted text noted in ~~striketrough~~ text):

(b) *Toll schedule.*

(1) The following toll per axle schedule is hereby established for travel through the Card Sound Road and Toll Bridge Facility:

2-axle vehicle	<u>\$1.004</u>
Vehicles of 3-axle or greater	<u>\$1.2832</u>
<u>Each Additional axle</u>	<u>\$1.2832</u>
<u>Toll-by-plate</u>	
<u>2-axle vehicle</u>	<u>\$1.506</u>
<u>Vehicles of 3-axle or greater</u>	<u>\$1.928</u>
<u>Each Additional axle</u>	<u>\$1.928</u>

**SECTION 2: SEVERABILITY.** If any portion of this ordinance is for any reason held invalid or declared to be unconstitutional, inoperative or void, such holding shall not affect the remaining portions of this ordinance. If this ordinance or any provision thereof shall be held to be inapplicable to any person, property or circumstances, such holding shall not affect its applicability to any other person, property or circumstances.

**SECTION 3: CONFLICT WITH OTHER ORDINANCES.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of said conflict.

**SECTION 4: INCLUSION IN CODE OF ORDINANCES.** The provisions of this ordinance shall be included and incorporated in the Code of Ordinances of the County of Monroe, Florida, as an addition or amendment thereto, and shall be appropriately renumbered to conform to the uniform numbering system of the Code.

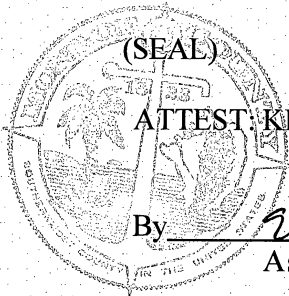





On July 17, 2024, a public hearing, as required by Section 147.01 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code"), will be held by the Monroe County, Florida (the "County") with respect to the portion of the proposed issuance by the Public Finance Authority a joint project between created under Sections 66.0301, 66.0303 and 66.0304 of the Wisconsin Statutes (the "Authority") of its Special Facilities Revenue Bonds (Million Air Three LLC General Aviation Facilities (this project), Series 2024 in one or more series (the "Bonds") to be used to finance the facilities described below at the Florida Keys Marathon International Airport (the "Airport"). The portion of the Bonds (the "MTH FBO Bonds") are expected to be issued in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$40,000,000. The hearing will commence at 9:00 a.m. or as soon thereafter as the matter can be heard, and will be held at the Marathon Government Center, 2798 Overseas Highway, Marathon, Florida 33050.

The MTH FBO Bonds are expected to be issued as exempt facility bonds for airports pursuant to section 147(a)(1) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended and Section 616 of the Wisconsin Statutes, as amended. The proceeds from the sale of the MTH FBO Bonds will be loaned to Marathon Aviation Associates LLC, a Florida limited liability company (the "Borrower"), and will be used to (a) finance the acquisition, construction and upgrading of certain fixed base operator airport facilities (the "Facilities"), (b) pay the portion of the issuance costs of the Bonds which is allocable to the MTH FBO Bonds, (c) pay capitalized interest with respect to the MTH FBO Bonds and (d) fund the portion of the debt service reserve fund for the Bonds which is allocable to the MTH FBO Bonds (collectively, the "Budget"). The Facilities will be owned by the County and will be used and operated by the Borrower in its business of providing services to general aviation aircraft operators. The Facilities will be located in parcel 20, a 5.75-acre site with a street address of

8800 Overseas Highway (US Route 1), Marathon, Florida and in remaining part on a 8.51-acre lot with a street address of 8850 Overseas Highway, Marathon, Florida. All facilities are located at the Airport, which has street address of 8800 Overseas Highway in the City of Marathon, Monroe County, Florida and which occupies a 197 acre site along Overseas Highway, between 27nd Street and 106th Street.

The Bonds will be special limited obligations of the Authority payable solely from the loan requirements to be made by the Borrower (and by the borrower of the proceeds of the portion of the Bonds other than the MTH FBO Bonds) to the Authority, and certain funds and accounts established by the trust indenture for the Bonds. The Bonds will not be obligations of the County.

The hearing will provide a reasonable opportunity to be heard for persons wishing to express their views on the merits of the Project, the nature and location of the Facilities, the issuance of the MTH FBO Bonds or related matters. 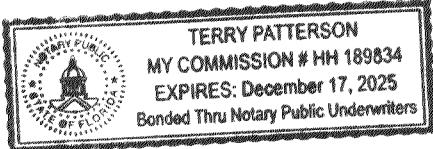

Thomas Robert Pasqueretta faces multiple charges of video voyeurism. One of the victims alerted the Sheriff's Office of the incidents in April 2024 and the subsequent investigation showed Pasqueretta videotaped himself with her and another female victim without their consent.

Man arrested following scam investigation  
 A 29-year-old Miramar, Florida man was arrested last Thursday as part of a Sheriff's Office fraud investigation following a traffic stop in which fake credit cards, IDs, phones, computers, and the personal information of others was found.

A warrant was obtained for Pasqueretta's arrest and he was booked into jail on Thursday.

### Man arrested following scam investigation

Jackie Webster faces multiple charges of fraud, forgery, larceny, and counterfeiting.

The Sheriff's Office stopped a Volkswagen sedan in September 2023 in which Webster was a passenger. The car was unregistered and the tag was not assigned to the vehicle. A search turned up numerous fake credit cards and IDs as well as a printer used to create fake cards. Also found were phones, tablets, and computers — including one computer labeled "scams."

The investigation showed Webster was also in possession of hundreds of sets of personal identification information such as names, social security numbers, dates of birth, addresses, bank account numbers and bank log-in numbers.

A warrant was obtained for Webster's arrest and he was booked into jail on Thursday.

### Man arrested in pellet gun shooting

A 32-year-old Cudjoe Key, Florida man was arrested Tuesday for hitting another man with a brick/rock/paver and shooting him in the face with a pellet gun. There were no life-threatening injuries reported.

Daniel Michael Reece was charged with two counts of aggravated battery.
