ORDINANCE NO. <u>002</u> - 2018

AN ORDINANCE BY THE MONROE COUNTY BOARD OF **COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, AMENDING CHAPTER 26** OF THE MONROE COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES; DELETING THE BOATING RESTRICTED AREA (IDLE SPEED/NO WAKE ZONE) FOR ALL MANMADE WATERBODIES; **ESTABLISHING** A **BOATING RESTRICTED AREA (SLOW SPEED/MINIMUM WAKE** ZONE) FOR ALL MAN-MADE CANALS LESS THAN SEVENTY-FIVE FEET IN WIDTH; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF **INCONSISTENT PROVISIONS; PROVIDING FOR FILING** AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE; PROVIDNG FOR **CODIFICATION.**

WHEREAS, the Monroe County Board of County Commissioners adopted Ordinance
 No.035-1997 providing for an Idle Speed-No Wake zone in any residential man-made
 canals in unincorporated Monroe County; and

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WHEREAS, Ordinance No.035-1997 was subsequently approved by the Florida Fish
 and Wildlife Conservation Commission (FWC), in accordance with statutory
 requirements in place at that time, and was assigned FWC Permit No.99-042; and

WHEREAS, the Monroe County Board of County Commissioners adopted Ordinance No.031-2002, revising the initial ordinance, and providing for the boating restricted area to apply to all 'man-made waterbodies' and to include all of the Keys canals with buildings along their shorelines.

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WHEREAS, in 2009 F.S. 327.46 was revised, providing local authority to municipalities
and counties to adopt local ordinances establishing slow speed-minimum wake boating
restricted areas if the area is within a canal that is less than seventy-five feet in width
from shoreline to shoreline; and

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45 WHEREAS, the statutory revision makes the current Idle Speed-No Wake in all 46 residential man-made canals zone non-compliant with State Statute; and

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47 48 WHEREAS, FWC staff has suggested that Monroe County may amend its Idle Speed-No Wake zone in man-made waterbodies code to reflect Slow Speed/Minimum Wake in 49 50 canals less that seventy-five feet in width from shoreline to shoreline; and 51 52 WHEREAS, amending Chapter 26 of the General Code of Ordinances to establish a new 53 regulation requiring Slow Speed/Minimum Wake in canals, compliant with current State 54 Statutes, is in the best interest of the health and safety of the public; and 55 56 WHEREAS, several inaccuracies within Chapter 26 need correction; 57 58 59 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MONROE COUNTY BOARD 60 **OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS:** 61 62 Chapter 26 of the Monroe County Code is amended as follows: Section 1. 63 64 **Chapter 26 – WATERWAYS** 65 **ARTICLE I. IN GENERAL** 66 67 68 Sec. 26-1. – Definitions. 69 70 Houseboat means as provided in F.S. § 327.02. 71 72 **ARTICLE III. – VESSEL RESTRICTED AREAS** 73 74 Sec. 26-71 – Boating restricted zones established. 75 (a) Idle speed/no wake zones. No person shall operate a vessel in the following 76 areas spatially defined as "idle speed/no wake zones" at a speed in excess of idle 77 speed/no wake as defined in this chapter: 78 (1) Summerland Key Channel: To include an area within 300 feet of shore 79 along the southwest shore of Summerland Key, running contiguous with the 80 shorelines of Summerland Key Cove and Summerland Cove Isles subdivisions. 81 82 (2) Ocean Reef Club: 83 Bayside: To include an area between 300 feet of shore along the a. 84 northwest shore of North Key Largo running contiguous with the 85 shoreline of Snapper Point subdivision, Ocean Reef Club, within the navigation channel that parallels the shoreline. Includes all internal 86 87 canals of Snapper Point subdivision. 88 b. Oceanside: To include all residential canals in Angelfish Cay, all 89 residential canals in Channel Cay, and the portion of Little Angelfish 90 Creek adjacent to Angelfish Cay.

- 91 (3) Riviera Canal: To include the area of Riviera Canal, Key West, running from Cow Key Channel to the west, until it turns approximately 90 degrees 92 93 to the north. 94 (4) Jolly Roger Estates, Little Torch Key: To include an area running parallel to 95 the eastern shore of Jolly Roger subdivision approximately 300 feet 96 offshore and within the deep navigation canal parallel to the subdivision 97 shoreline. To include the northernmost canal (running east-west) leading into the internal subdivision canals. 98 99 (5) Sombrero Beach: To include the area at the west side of Sombrero Beach 100 extending to the west side of the navigation canal, bounded at its southern extreme by Day Beacon No. 6. 101 102 (6) Safety Harbor: To include an area contiguous to and extending approximately 300 feet from the residential shorelines of Safety Harbor and 103 Toll Gate Shores, within the existing deeper parallel navigation channel. 104 105 (7) Community Harbor: To include the area within the bounds of Community 106 Harbor, Tavernier, Key Largo and extending in an arc from either side of 107 the mouth, just outside the bounds of the Harbor. 108 (8) Dove Creek: From the open water of the Atlantic/Hawk's Channel, the eastern section of Dove Creek to the western end of Dove Creek subdivision 109 110 and including the Dove Creek subdivision residential canal. 111 (9) Key West: Smathers Beach: To include an area parallel to the shore along Smathers Beach running 600 feet offshore. 112 (b) Slow speed/minimum wake zones. No person shall operate a vessel in the 113 following areas spatially defined as "slow speed/minimum wake zones" at a 114 115 speed in excess of slow speed/minimum wake as defined in this chapter: (1) Snake Creek: To include the entire width of Snake Creek, from 100 feet 116 117 south of the Snake Creek Bridge at U.S. Highway 1, to 100 feet north of the residential shoreline of the Venetian Shores subdivision, Plantation Key. 118 119 (2) Vaca Cut: Extending the length of Vaca Cut, Marathon from the regulatory 120 marker located approximately 1,250 feet south of the Vaca Cut Bridge to 121 the regulatory markers located approximately 800 feet north of the Vaca 122 Cut Bridge. 123 (3) Whale Harbor: To include the area just north of the Whale Harbor Bridge 124 and extending south the length of the Whale Harbor navigation channel to ATON number 1. 125 126 (4) Boot Key Harbor and Sister's Creek: To include all waters within Boot Key Harbor including contiguous creeks and manmade canals, and including 127 approaches to the Harbor from the West beginning at Day Beacon No. 7 and 128 129 from the South, Sister's Creek beginning at Day Beacon No. 4. (5) Cow Key Channel: To include Cow Key Channel north of the Cow Key 130 131 Channel Bridge at U.S. Highway 1 and ending at Day Beacon No. 11, south of the Cow Key Channel Bridge. 132
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133 134 135 (6) Adams Waterway: To include the entire area known as Adams Waterway, Key Largo, leading from Blackwater Sound on Florida Bay to Largo Sound on the ocean side of the Island of Key Largo.

136 137 (7) All man-made canals: To include all canals of Monroe County within the Florida Keys, of less than seventy-five feet in width from shoreline to shoreline (as per F.S. § 327.46).

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140 Sec. 26-72. - Vessel use restriction zone delineation markers.

- (a) The vessel use restriction zones established in section 26-71 shall be marked on
 the waters using the U.S. Coast Guard and state uniform regulatory markers in
 accordance with applicable state and federal laws and regulations.
- (b) Special requirements and allowances apply to manmade canal boating restricted
 areas for posting of signage.
- 147 Regulatory signs and/or markers posted on the water must be in accord with 148 applicable state and federal laws and regulations. Such signage and/or markers 149 are only allowed to be posted on the water (or facing the water) by the County 150 and only after permitting by FWC. Any signage posted on land must be 151 compliant with applicable local codes.
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- (1) Requirements: signage shall be posted at all County public boat launching
 facilities (without additional FWC permitting), which may only be posted on
 land, and facing towards land;
- (2) Allowances: signage may also be provided to municipalities and the
 Department of Transportation for posting at city and state public boat ramps,
 which may only be posted on land, and facing towards land.
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- 160 The posted signs must be in accord with applicable state and federal laws and 161 regulations.

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163 <u>Section 2.</u> Severability. If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, sentence or 164 provision of this ordinance shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be 165 invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair, invalidate, or nullify the remainder of this 166 ordinance, but the effect thereof shall be confined to the section, paragraph, subdivision, 167 clause, sentence, or provision immediately involved in the controversy in which such 168 judgment or decree shall be rendered.

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- 170 <u>Section 3.</u> Repeal of Inconsistent Provisions. All ordinances or parts of ordinance in
 171 conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of said conflict. The repeal
 172 of an ordinance herein shall not repeal the repealing clause of such ordinance or revive
 173 any ordinance which has been repealed thereby.
- 175 <u>Section 4.</u> Filing and Effective Date. This ordinance shall be filed in the Office of
 176 the Secretary of the State of Florida and shall become effective as provided by law.
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Section 5. 178 Codification.
