

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 102, ARTICLE XVII-
STOPPING, STANDING, PARKING RESTRICTED OR PROHIBITED ON
CERTAIN STREETS SECTION 102-550-PENALTIES FOR CERTAIN
VIOLATIONS OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF
OXFORD, MISSISSIPPI.**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF
OXFORD, MISSISSIPPI:

SECTION I. That the following section be amended to read:

a) Whenever any motor vehicle is parked in violation of section 102-549 or section 102-553, the officer finding such vehicle shall conspicuously affix to such vehicle a traffic citation, on a form provided by the parking division, directing the violator to make payment within 14 calendar days of a fine or to timely request a trial in municipal court to contest the citation.

(b) The fine prescribed to be paid for a violation of section 102-549 or section 102-553 as an alternative to appearance in municipal court shall be:

(1) \$16.00 for the violation, with \$1.00 of said fine to be settled to the Computerized Crime Prevention Fund (CCP), if paid within 14 calendar days of the violation; and \$26.00, with \$1.00 of said fine to be settled to the Computerized Crime Prevention Fund (CCP), if paid after more than 14 calendar days have passed since the violation.

(c) The fine prescribed to be paid for a violation of section 102-549 or section 102-553 on any day the University of Mississippi hosts a home football game as an alternative to appearance in municipal court shall be:

(1) \$51.00 for the violation, with \$1.00 of said fine to be settled to the Computerized Crime Prevention Fund (CCP), if paid within 14 calendar days of the violation, and \$101.00, with \$1.00 of said fine to be settled to the Computerized Crime Prevention Fund (CCP), if paid after more than 14 calendar days have passed since the violation.

(d) The maximum fine for any violation of section 102-549 or section 102-553 adjudicated in municipal court shall be \$201.00, with \$1.00 of said fine to be settled to the Computerized Crime Prevention Fund (CCP).

SECTION II. Repealing Clause

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herein shall be, and the same are hereby repealed.

SECTION III. EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force as provided by law.

The above ordinance having being first reduced to writing and read and considered section by section at a public meeting or the governing authorities of the City of Oxford Mississippi on motion of Alderman Addy, seconded by Alderman Hyneman, and the roll being called, the same by the following votes:
